FIRST SEA LORD ADM FINBAR GITTELMAN, SUPREME COMMANDER OWNER & MASTER – 74' TOPSAIL WOLF, FLAGSHIP OF THE CONCH REPUBLIC & WAVES OF CHANGE NAVY A SAILOR'S SAILOR

ADM Finbar began sailing as a young boy, currently holds a USCG 3,000 Ton Master License, with 500 Ton Sail Endorsement and maintains a perfect safety record. At 78 years young, ADM Finbar is preparing WOLF to again offer daily passenger sail and hope to return the ship to Key West Bight, where she spent her first 18 years.

Upon graduation from high school in 1959, he joined the USCG and while on Greenland Ice Patrol Duty survived a fall from a USCG Cutter. With an honorable discharge, ADM Finbar returned to Miami Beach area.

In 1980 he spent 4 days adrift in a life raft after CAT 5 Hurricane Allen (his crew are the only known survivors of the storm claiming 6 ships & 55 lives.) He later testified at a USCG hearing to evaluate life rafts.

The Flagship WOLF Preservation Society has been established to subsidize preservation efforts and community-based sail programs and to get WOLF back to the Key West Bight, her original homeport.

A natural born teacher, he's shared the ancient art of sail with tens of thousands wishing to learn the nuances of life at sea. Many of his crew have attained their USCG Master licenses and now make a career at sea.

ESTABLISHES KEY WEST'S FIRST SAIL CHARTER BUSINESS

Sailing into Key West in 1973, ADM Finbar established the island's first sail charter business taking passengers out for reef trips, day sails and sunset cruises and when business grew, built the 33' custom sloop HIGH Tide and 74' topsail schooner WOLF. Both vessels have always been homeported in Key West and are still in operation.

SHIP HANDLING (70 years)

For 70 years, ADM Finbar has sailed the Atlantic, Caribbean and South Pacific on vessels of all sizes. He built his first sailboat at age eight (raft, broomsticks and bedsheets) and made his first voyage sailing across Biscayne Bay from Miami Beach to Miami. He is fortunate to find his vocation and avocation are one and the same.

Master, Captain, Relief Captain or Chief Mate on Bahamian freighters, majestic schooners, sleek sloops, classic power boats and USN support/research vessels operating out of Key West and stood at the helm of the SIRENA, WOLF, WESTERN UNION, HIGH TIDE, HINDU, APPLIEDORE, JOLLY ROVER II, PT BOAT 728, & USN NAWC 38.

ADM Finbar has delivered vessels of all sizes throughout the Caribbean & US East Coast (including English galleon GOLDEN HINDE from Key West to Cape Canaveral and PEGASUS, from Fiji to Ecuador, via Australia, New Zealand, the Cook Islands, Pitcairn and Rapanui.)

In 1980 DM Finbar participated in the Mariel Boatlift, returning with 311 souls on board - 212 more than the ship was certified for and has sailed thousands of miles aboard WOLF on Conch Republic Missions of Mercy Sails.

FLAGSHIP WOLF PRESERVATION SOCIETY (FWPS)

The primary goals of the FPW Society are to raise funds to preserve the historic WOLF; share the wonderful world of the ancient art of sail with as many as possible; and provide ongoing youth leadership training programs, internships at sea, eco-educational, author & historian and community-based multi-generational sails.

FWPS memberships, sponsorships and grants ensure WOLF stays homeported in Key West and continues to pass on the traditions of tall ship sailing for generations to come. Costs of keeping historic vessels like WOLF continue to escalate and the Society subsidizes WOLF preservation efforts, including ongoing maintenance.

FPW Society is a program of Whale Center's Waves of Change, a Florida registered 501(c)3 nonprofit. All donations and sponsorships are tax deductible to the fullest extent allowed by the law.



KEY WEST RESIDENT & BUSINESS OWNER (46 years)

Known as the 'Ancient Mariner of Key West & the Florida Keys,' ADM Finbar sailed into Brito's Boatyard in 1973 (now Galleon Marina) aboard the 36' sloop SIRENA and realized he'd found his true 'homeport.'

In 1973 he began taking tourists (and locals) out for day sails, reef trips and sunset cruises and founded the first sail charter in Key West. ADM Finbar is a Florida notary and has officiated over a thousand weddings at sea.

TROPICAL TRIPS & THE OLD COAST GUARD DOCKS

In 1978 as his sail charter business expanded, ADM Finbar leased the old Coast Guard docks (now Margaritaville Resort.) Tropical Trips Charters moved to Key West Bight when his lease wasn't renewed in 1982.

ADM Finbar lived aboard the houseboat NO MAS in Key West Bight from 1982-2001 and Garrison Bight, when the KW Ferry Terminal was built. NO MAS sunk during Hurricane Rita in 2005 and now lives aboard WOLF.

HIGH TIDINGS, INC.

ADM Finbar established High Tidings, Inc. in 1980 to build, own and operate the 33' custom sloop HIGH TIDE to accommodate the ever-growing sailboat charter business. He took on a partner and the boat's still in operation.

KEY WEST PACKET LINES, INC. & SCHOONER WOLF

Seeing the need for a passenger schooner in 1982, ADM Finbar built the beloved WOLF (with help from friends) in Panama City, Florida. Designed specifically for the passenger trade in Key West, WOLF began offering daily passenger sails departing from Key West Bight in 1984.

In 1985 WOLF was named Flagship of the Conch Republic to replace WESTERN UNION and in 2007 was named Flagship of WHALE Center's Waves of Change Navy.

In 2002 ADM Finbar took a leave of absence from WOLF to upgrade his USCG license and spent 16 years as chief mate/relief captain on US Navy support ships. He continued to embark on WOLF Conch Republic Relief Missions of Mercy Sails and Goodwill Ambassadors to the Bahamas and Caribbean when time allowed.

In 2003 unable to compete with the increasing costs and competition offering tall ship sail, ADM Finbar moved the to Stock Island in 2003 and ceased day to day operations.

WOLF continued to offer private charters, embark on Conch Republic Mission of Mercy Humanitarian Sails and Goodwill Ambassador Voyage.

In 1982 ADM Finbar leased office space at KW Bight (now Waterfront Brewery) for Key West Packet Lines, Inc. When his lease was not renewed in 2013, he relocated his office to Applerouth Lane.

ADM Finbar returned to WOLF full time in 2018 and is readying the ship to reenter the passenger boat business. WOLF now sails from Safe Harbour Marina, offering private charters, Unity Family Sails & weekly Sunset Sails. Plans are currently underway to see if WOLF can return to Key West Bight.

SCHOONER WESTERN UNION

As a child, ADM Finbar often traveled to Key West with his parents to take the ferry to Cuba. In 1949 he sees the WESTERN UNION for the first time and said to his parents, "I'm gonna captain her someday."

In 1978 Tropical Trips leased dockage to WESTERN UNION when Capt. John Krauss returned the ship back to Key West. He served as first mate and was aboard for the first 'Great Sea Battle of the Conch Republic' in 1982, when they attacked the unsuspecting USCG Cutter Diligence in KW Harbor, starting a yearly tradition.

ADM Finbar and partners Paul & Evalena Worthington and Ivan Jerabek brought the ship home and he served as master, overseeing two haul outs in Tarpon Springs. In 2002 he left to serve on US Naval support ships.

FLAGSHIP OF THE CONCH REPUBLIC, FLORIDA KEYS & WHALE CENTER'S WAVES OF CHANGE NAVY

A PIECE OF KEY WEST HISTORY

The beloved **WOLF** is the oldest working schooner in the state of Florida. Built in 1984 by ADM Finbar (with the help of friends) in Panama City, Florida, the ship was built for the passenger trade in her homeport of Key West. A Key West icon for 35 years, **WOLF** is one of the most photographed ships in the Florida Keys.

Seen in TV, films and documentaries, **WOLF** & ADM Finbar are featured in Matt Dean Films 'Old Man and the Sea – Return to Cuba' (winner of the 2018 KW Film Fest Best Feature Award,) and Dreamtime Entertainment's 'Cuba Reframed' (picked up by PBS the, the film will premiere at the San Carlos on April during CRIC 2020.

WOLF often serving as lead vessel in harbor parades and special events, and the ship has come to symbolize the 'island spirit' Key West is known for and is reminiscent of blockade runners plying the Florida Straits in 19th century and rum runners during prohibition.

WOLF plays center stage for Key West's annual Conch Republic Independence Celebration, leading CRN Navy in the Great Battle of the Conch Republic.

In 1985 **WOLF** was commissioned as Flagship of the Conch Republic and Florida Keys. In 2007 **WOLF** was named Flagship of WHALE Center's Waves of Change Navy by WHALE Center's founder, Dr. Dave Randle (also the Conch Republic's Ambassador to the UN.)

PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE

ADM Finbar returned to **WOLF** full time in 2018 and spent several months overseeing the most extensive yard haul out the ship has had in years. **WOLF** is being restored to her full beauty and her cannons still thunder.

WOLF's hull is in impeccable condition, standing and running rigging was replaced and sails repaired. As funding allows, cap rails will be repaired, decks rust busted and painted and minor maintenance repairs, refurbishing and cosmetic work in progress will be completed.

After a long hiatus, **WOLF** is ready to reenter the daily passenger sail business and ADM Finbar and Julie are strategizing with local community leaders to find ways keep the ship afloat.

The Flagship **WOLF** Preservation Society (FPWS) has been established to subsidize the income from daily passenger sails and private charters. **WOLF** also plans to offer youth leadership and sail training intensives and internships, eco-educational sails and multi-generational family sails.

WOLF will embark on future Conch Republic Humanitarian Mission of Mercy Sails and Goodwill Ambassador Voyages and Waves of Change Peace Vision Cultural Exchanges as funding becomes available.

WHALE CENTER WAVES OF CHANGE, PEACE VISION & UNITY OF THE KEYS

To continue offering **WOLF** cultural exchange opportunities, WHALE Center, founded by Dr. Dave Randle (also the CR's Ambassador to the UN,) along with Peace Vision, a media platform for peace, and Unity of the Keys are working on grants to provide ongoing funding.

WOLF embarked on her Inaugural Waves of Change Peace Vision Cultural Exchange Voyage sailing with the CR CUP 2019 fleet to Cuba with a crew of 12 artists, musicians & peacemakers. Future voyages are being planned with Waves of Change to provide cultural exchange internship opportunities for college students of all ages.



CONCH REPUBLIC PATRIOT

An intricate part of Key West's maritime community, ADM Finbar has dedicated countless hours towards the betterment of his adopted home and has donated WOLF for many CR Mission of Mercy Humanitarian Sails.

ADM Finbar oversees all Conch Republic military events, including the annual Reenactment the 'Great Sea, Land & Air Battle' held each April during the Key West's annual Independence Celebration.

In 1990 he helped resurrect the island's annual Conch Republic Independence Celebration and In 2014 was inspired to write The Battle Hymn of the Conch Republic.

ADM Finbar is a founding member of the Key West Maritime Heritage Society and joined the US Propeller Club-Port of Key West 1985, where he served as past president and currently sits on the Board of Governors.

He is also a founding member of the Key West Bight Preservation Association ADM Finbar also served as president and liaison to the KW Bight Management Board in the early 1990s and on the Marketing Committee (the logo he designed for the Historic Seaport in 1993 is still in use today.)

HONORS, AWARDS & RECOGNITION

Over the years, ADM Finbar has played a vital role in hosting events at the Seaport, including the island's Pirates in Paradise Festival (2000-2015) and annual Conch Republic Independence Celebration held each April.

In 1992 on an extended voyage in the South Pacific, ADM Finbar became an Honorary Maori in a special 'Haka' ceremony on Rarotonga and was appointed to serve as the Conch Republic Ambassador to Pitcairn.

In 2005 ADM Finbar was named First Sea Lord and promoted to Four Star Admiral and Supreme Commander and named Ancient Mariner of Key West & the Florida Keys In 2018.

CONCH REPUBLIC MISSIONS OF MERCY HUMANITARIAN SAILS

Thanks to the generous support of the Key West community, WOLF has been able to take much needed relief supplies to those in need after natural disasters. WOLF Mission of Mercy Humanitarian Sails include:

Designated the Flagship of the Conch Republic and the Florida Keys, **WOLF** is patterned after the blockade runners that plied the waters of the Florida Straits in the 19th century.

WOLF is USCG certified for up to 41 passengers, and our crew can be attired in full Pirate Regalia, Military Dress Whites or Casual attire. Showcased in numerous publications, films and documentaries, **WOLF** specializes Tall Ship Weddings at Sea and is always available for Private Charters.

WOLF is known for her humanitarian *Mission of Mercy Sails* and has taken donated relief supplies to Port Antonio, Jamaica (1987), Guanaja, Honduras (1998), Hope Town, Abaco Bahamas (2004), West End, Grand Bahama (2005) and La Gonave, Haiti (2010.) BUSINESS PLAN

SECTION 3B (EXHIBIT 3B)

BACKGROUND

FWPS was formed as a program of WHALE Center's Waves of Change (a 501(C)3 nonprofit) to keep the beloved and historic Flagship WOLF afloat and home ported in Key West. For the past 15 years, Flagship WOLF was on temporary 'hiatus' while Finbar served as CO on USN support ships.

Finbar left the USN support ships in 2018 and has spent the past year and a half getting Flagship WOLF ready to re-enter the passenger charter boat trade...and continue the good deeds she is known for.

The primary goal is to build the FWPS into a viable business; continues to sail the waters off Key West providing a variety of sail opportunities for generations to come; and develop a strong steward for Flagship WOLF (to ensure the vessel stays in ship-shape condition and stays homeported in Key West.) Finbar's USCG license expires in 2 ½ years (when he turns 81) and he is ready to turn the helm over to capable and steadfast hands.

When funding allows, FWPS will purchase Flagship WOLF from Key West Packet Lines, Inc., and until then, the Society is forming a lease purchase agreement with KWPL (Finbar Gittelman will continue to oversee all ship operations and crew recruitment and training and Julie McEnroe will manage marketing, public relations, and will work with FWPS Board to develop a strong organization to ensure Flagship WOLF continues to sail.

IRS 501(c)3 NONPROFIT STATUS

FWPS is filing/registering with IRS for a stand-alone 501(c)3 nonprofit status. In the interim, WHALE Center Waves of Change, an IRS 501(c)3 nonprofit, licensed to operate in Florida, Utah and New York, serves as fiscal agent for FWPS, has set up a separate FWPS bank account and is waiving their fiscal agent fee.

Dr. Dave Randle, founder of WHALE Center serves as the Conch Republic's Ambassador to the United Nations, has been a 'Friend of WOLF' for over 20 years and served as crew on several international voyages aboard the ship.

\$17,500+ CASH DONATIONS IN OCT 2019

FWPS has received over \$17,500 in donations to date, and these funds are being used to prepare Flagship WOLF for her first Bahamas Relief Mission to Green Turtle Cay, NOV 12 (in collaboration with Key Wet Cares and Glad Tidings Tabernacle) and for WOLF's yard haul out scheduled NOV 4-9.

STRONG BOARD, ADVISORY BOARD & MANAGEMENT TEAM

FWPS has a strong board of directors, advisory board and management team with talents and skills in ship operations and management, marketing and public relations, event production and grant writing.

LAUNCH DATE

FWPS was originally planned to launch on SEP 1, however when Hurricane Dorian struck the Bahamas and Key West Cares relief efforts took off, we felt it best to delay the roll out to NOV 30 (for Key West's End of Hurricane Season Celebration, held dockside and aboard the USCG Ingham Museum Ship.)

FWPS plans to launch an extensive social media campaign the end DEC 2019 and will continue to promote the Society and Flagship WOLF Tall Ship Sails on a regular basis.

MAINTENANCE SUPPORT & PURCHASE FUND

Beginning in 2020, FWPS is dedicating a minimum of 20% of all FWPS corporate donations and grants to build a FWPS Reserve Fund, with monies dedicated to an Ongoing Maintenance Reserve Fund and Vessel Purchase Fund (FWPS plans to raise the funds to purchase the ship from Key West Packet Lines.) In the meantime, FWPS will serve as a fundraising organization to support the Flagship WOLF.

Grant and Sponsorship Funding will also be used to establish provide funding to purchase Flagship WOLF from Key West Packet Lines, Inc. and is dedicating 25% of Corporate Sponsorships & Grants to establish a Vessel Maintenance & Purchase Fund.

FLAGSHIP WOLF SHIP OPERATIONS

MASTER, FLAGSHIP WOLF

Finbar Introduced Key West to sail boat passenger trips in 1973 soon opened Key West's first sailboat charter business, built Key West's first sailboat designed specifically for passenger sails to the reef in 1980 (S/V High Tide), and built WOLF in 1994, when he saw the need for a traditionally rigged sailing vessel to operate out of Key West Bight. (WOLF remained at the KWHS until 2004, when Finbar took a position as XO and Relief Capt. on USN support vessels and the ship was moved to Stock Island.)

INTEGRITY OF THE SHIP

Flagship WOLF's hull and rigging are in impeccable shape. The vessel has maintained a rigorous maintenance regime and has passed every USCG vessel certification process with flying colors.

Finbar will continue to over-see Flagship WOLF haul outs, as he has done, since he built the ship in 1994. Due to lack of funds, there is still some refurbishing work to do (mainly below decks) and the flying jib needs to be replaced and will be done as funds allow.

CREW RECRUITMENT & TRAINING

Finbar will oversee the recruitment and training of all Flagship WOLF Crew. A natural born teacher, Finbar has trained over 1,000 to sail traditionally rigged vessels, with many going on to become licensed captains who today make their living on the sea. He will oversee all recruitment of Flagship WOLF Crew and provide in-depth training to those who wish to learn the nuances of the ancient art of sail.

ADMINISTRATIVE & BOOKKEEPING

Joanne Palmieri serves as bookkeeper and office administrator for both FWP and KWPL, and will ensure proper accounting techniques are maintained, and necessary paperwork is filed as needed. With funding, our goal is to hire a part-time administrator and eventually grow into full time, as FWPS and Flagship WOLF become busier.

RE-ENTERING THE PASSENGER SAIL CHARTER BUSINESS

Flagship WOLF is re-entering the Key West passenger boat charter business after a 15-year hiatus (during which time, the vessel still participated in community events, offered 'Friends of WOLF' Sails and Private Charters.)

FWPS & KWPL plans to partner with a local watersports company (based at the KWHS) to handle all reservations and ticketing for Flagship WOLF Open Sails.

FWPS Member, Sponsor & Specialty Sails, Private Charters and Extended Voyages will continue to be coordinated through Julie McEnroe (KWPL, Inc. VP and Founder, FWPS.)

An aggressive public relations campaign designed to create media buzz announcing the return of Flagship WOLF is scheduled to begin JAN 2020, when the ship resumes offering daily open passenger.

Flagship WOLF also expects to get maximum exposure when publicity after the first of the year, for Peace Vision's documentary film, 'Cuba Reframed – The Power of Connection' and in April, for the 2020 Conch Republic Independence Celebration, when the film is screened at the San Carlos Institute.

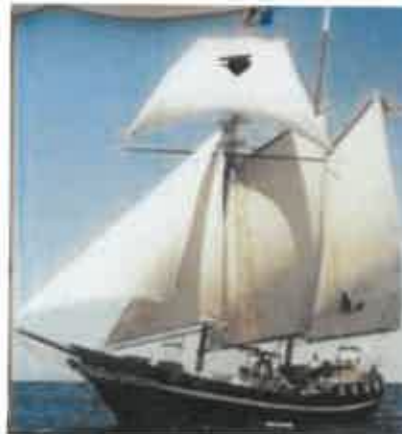

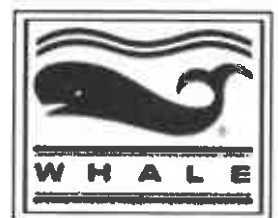
