



On June 17th, 2018, at about 1001 hours, I Ofc. B Vazquez was on an unrelated call in the area of Emma Street and Geraldine Street. While in the aforementioned area, I observed a female, known to me as Belinda Corrales, riding a bicycle South on Emma Street. I knew Corrales had active felony warrants. I stepped in front of the bicycle and told Corrales to stop, she complied.

I explained to Corrales, that she had active warrants, and to dismount the bicycle. I told Corrales to have a seat on an adjacent curb, she complied. While sitting on the curb, I began to converse with Corrales. Corrales became very nervous. I asked her if she had any narcotics on her person and she stated she did not. Corrales suddenly stood up, and I told her to have a seat, she complied. I told Corrales that if she fled, she would be Tased. Suddenly and swiftly Corrales rose to her feet, and took off running north on Emma Street. I gave chase. I removed my department issued TASER and deployed it. The Taser probes struck Corrales in the back causing Neuro Muscular Incapacitation (NMI). Corrales fell to the ground and seized running.

Ofc. Tyler and Ofc. Anglin, who were on the unrelated call, ran over to assist. We all began giving loud verbal commands for Corrales, to stop resisting and to put her hands behind her back, Corrales refused. Due to Corrales continuing to resist our efforts in placing her in custody, I gave Corrales a Drive Stun using my Taser to Corrales's buttock area. After being drive stunned Corrales, immediately placed her hands behind her back and was handcuffed by Ofc. Tyler.

Due to the fall from being tased, Corrales sustained a minor abrasion to the left side of her face. I requested KWFD to respond to the scene.

KWFD responded to the scene to tend to Corrales's injuries. Corrales refused rescue and was subsequently transported to MCDC, without further incident.

Sgt. Barrios responded to scene.

On Sunday June 17, 2018, at 1001 hours Officer B. Vazquez was dispatched to Emma Street in reference to a welfare check.

I Officer Tyler was riding with Officer Vazquez as a backup officer, the welfare check came out with a possible address of 720 or 722 Emma Street and the house has green shutters. The caller Tracy Gill said his son William Gill could have overdosed. Most of the houses in the area had green shutters and we were actively trying to find the house. While we were standing in the road trying to gather more information, a Hispanic female rode her bike off Geraldine street onto Emma street, and right in front of Officer Vazquez. He identified the female as Belinda Corrales, he was aware she had a warrant out for her, based on a BOLO email that was sent out department wide.

Officer Vazquez confirmed her name was Corrales and obtained her Florida ID. Vazquez checked for confirmation of the warrant through Key West dispatch. While he was waiting on the hit confirmation, he had her sit down on the sidewalk of Emma Street. Officer A. Anglin arrived on scene and Officer Vazquez directed myself and Officer Anglin, to see if we could locate William Gill's house. Fire and EMS were already on scene, they were waiting for us to make sure we located Gill and the scene was safe.

As I turned around away from Officer Vazquez, to try and locate Gill, I heard Vazquez tell Corrales to sit back down and if she runs she will be tased. When I turned around to check on Officer Vazquez, Corrales rose to her feet and took off running down Emma Street. Officer Vazquez said in a loud voice, "stop or you will be tased" she did not stop. I started at an angle down Emma Street to intercept Corrales, when Officer Vazquez activated his taser. The taser probes struck Corrales in the upper back and the buttock, she went to the ground. After the taser had completed its cycle, I grabbed her hand and applied one handcuff. She then started to resist again and tried to roll over, she was advised to put her hands behind her back numerous times and continued to resist. Officer Vazquez advised her if she did not stop resisting she was going to get tased again. Because I was wrapped up in the taser wires trying to cuff her, Officer Vazquez decided to remove the taser cartridge and perform a drive stun on her back.

After the drive stun to her back Corrales stopped resisting, and I could get the other cuff on her and get her secured. Sgt. Barrios was made aware of the situation via radio, and responded to the scene. Sgt. Barrios documented Corrales's injuries. She was placed into the back of Officer Vazquez's patrol car and transported to the Monroe County Detention Center. I assisted Officer Vazquez with securing, and submitting the property and evidence that was secured from the scene.
