A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "POINCIANA GARDENS FUNDING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT" BETWEEN MONROE COUNTY (COUNTY), THE CITY OF KEY WEST (CITY) AND THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST (KWHA) FOR FY 2025; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 13-256, the City encouraged KWHA to develop and construct an assisted living facility at Poinciana Plaza, in Resolution 20-031 the City Commission acknowledged the significant management challenges faced by the Poinciana Gardens senior living facility, in Resolution 21-008 the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement that provided partial funding of the facility for FY 2021 and in Resolution 21-174 the City Commission provided partial funding of the facility for FY 2022-24; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and the COUNTY have committed to providing certain funding to KWHA for FY 2025 for the continued operation of Poinciana Gardens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby approves the attached "Poinciana Gardens Funding Interlocal Agreement" between the City, the COUNTY and KWHA to provide funding support for the KWHA continuing operation of the Senior living facility at Poinciana Gardens for FY 2025.

Section 2: That funds in an amount up to \$300,000.00 for this project shall be budgeted in General Government/Grants & Aid Account #001-1900-519-8100 for FY 2025. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
