An application was received requesting the removal of **(1) Sea Grape, (1) Sapodilla, and (1) Gumbo Limbo tree**. A site inspection was done on October 12 and 20, 2017 and documented the following:

Tree #11: Sea Grape (*Cocoloba uvifera*)









Diameter: 42"

Location: 80%

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 30% (very poor, roots uplifted, sprawling multitrunked tree with damaged limbs)

Total Average Value = 70%

Value x Diameter = 29.4 replacement caliper inches

Tree #14: Sapodilla (Manilkara zapote)











Diameter: 21.3"

Location: 80%

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 45% (fair to poor, codominant trunks, major canopy damage)

Total Average Value = 75%

Value x Diameter = 15.9 replacement caliper inches

Tree #22: Gumbo Limbo (*Bursera simaruba*)

Diameter: 11.4"

Location: 80%

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 60% (fair)

Total Average Value = 80%

Value x Diameter = 9.1 replacement caliper inches

Total required replacement inches if removal approved = 54.4"


