Hi Karen:

In advance of the tree commission meeting, I put together a site plan for 1730 United St. that shows my initial concept of a base layer of plantings to anchor the property in Florida Keys native plants. I want the commission to envision my intent in light of my request to remove the three existing green buttonwood trees on site.



In addition, you may wish to look on Google maps to see my current residence in Key Largo, 124 E Shore Dr., where you will observe a native Florida Keys hammock preserved in my front yard, and note the majority of plants in my back yard are natives. In fact, my intention over time is to continue to remove the non-native species and replace them with natives. To date, I would estimate that I have planted more than 50 specimens of native plants at my Key Largo home.

I will send you a number of photos of my garden in Key Largo under separate cover.
