### Introduction

Staff respectfully requests the City Commission accept and approve the ranking for RFP #24-008 Key West City-wide Comprehensive Safety Action Plan and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a contract, subject to City Attorney review and approval, with the highest ranked proposer, University of Florida Transportation Institute, in an amount of \$329,736.00.

#### **Background**

The City of Key West entered into an agreement with FHWA for funding of up to \$400,000.00 for a Citywide Comprehensive Safety Action Plan with Resolution 23-228. The Action Plan would assist in identifying and prioritizing projects with the Vision Zero goal of eliminating collision-caused right-of-way fatalities by 2035. A key deliverable includes implementation grant assistance to secure construction funding for the identified priorities.

On August 1, 2024, RFP #24-008 was formally advertised to solicit proposals from qualified, professional consultants to produce a safety action plan for the City of Key West. The following addenda were released providing answers to questions sent in by potential proposers:
