A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TASK ORDER 4-19-ENGINEERING FOR CH2M HILL, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,794.08 FOR GENERAL ENGINEERING SERVICES TO PREPARE A PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT AND ASSESSMENT REPORT; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-207, the City Commission approved a contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for General Engineering Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Task Order No. 4-19-Engineering from CH2M Hill Engineering, Inc. for General Engineering services to prepare a Pavement Management and Assessment Report for the City of Key West is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$98,794.08.

Section 2: That a budget transfer of funds for the 2019 Pavement Management and Assessment Report is authorized from Internal Improvements (Gas Tax)/Streets/Professional Services Account No. 102-4102-541-6300 (Project No. II41021802) to Internal Improvements (Gas Tax)/Streets/Professional Services 102-4102-541-3100.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
