I was checking the parking lot when Officer Young aired over the radio someone flagged him down and told him Anniel was hiding in the east end of the parking lot. Officer Young spotted Anniel's red pants under a black truck in the parking lot. Anniel heard us approaching the truck and jumped the fence behind the truck then ran towards Simonton Street. I chased Anniel down Simonton Street, then down Greene Street. Officers T. Anglin and Leahy were on Ann Street just off Greene Street with Anniel. I observed Anniel running south on Anne Street away from Officer Leahy. While running from Officer Leahy, Anniel pushed a female passerby into a wall. Anniel looked like he was going to head back towards Duval Street. Officer Leahy and I tased Anniel at the same time. Anniel fell to the ground. I ordered him to put his hands behind his back and detained him.

Officer Leahy successfully tased Anniel in his back. My taser probes missed. Anniel told us he was not injured. Officer Leahy removed the taser probes. Sergeant Rodriguez was on scene and witnessed the tasing. Key West Rescue responded to the scene. Anniel declined transportation to the emergency room. I transported Anniel to Monroe County Detention Center and turned him over to the detention deputies without incident.

Officer Grassi spoke with the victim of the battery, Samuel Carlson, who told her the following:

He was riding his bicycle on Duval Street. He passed the white sedan and began to slow down for a red light. The driver of the vehicle jumped out of the vehicle and punched him in his face with a closed fist. He observed the male run away from the police. He wishes to press charges for battery.

Samuel complained of pain to his face but declined rescue and had no visible injuries at the time of the call. Samuel filled out a sworn witness statement which was later submitted to records.

Officer Grassi also got a sworn witness statement from Ann Jonas, who was riding along with her for the night. In Ann's witness statement she wrote:

She observed a man in red shorts and a white shirt jump out of a white sedan and punch a man on a bicycle. The man on the bicycle fell into a tree. While the three officers were out with the subjects who were fighting, the passenger from the white car got into the driver's seat and ran over the bicycle. The three officers ran after the guy in red shorts.

On Sunday, July 29, 2018, at approximately 0051 hours, Officer Grassi, Officer Haynie and I, Officer J. Young, were standing in the 300 block of Duval St., across the street from Fat Tuesday's Bar when we observed a physical fight in the roadway.

I observed a white male, wearing a white T-shirt and red sweatpants, later identified as Annie Torres, punch another male, identified as Samuel Carlson, in the face with a right fist. Both men were standing in the northbound travel lane. I saw a men's bicycle on it's side in front of a stopped vehicle and Carlson attempting to retreat backwards. Torres was charging at Carlson attempting to continue the physical fight.

Officer Grassi, Officer Haynie and I stopped the fight and separated the two males.

I took physical control of Torres and instructed him to sit down on the ground next to the Henna tattoo kiosk. Torres did not follow my instructions to sit on his butt and only crouched down. I gave Torres the verbal command to sit all the way on the ground and he still did not comply. I grabbed Torres's left shoulder and was about to remove Torres's feet from under him and have him sit down completely.

Just prior to me physically moving Torres's legs, I heard a loud crunch and a scraping noise behind me. I looked behind me and I saw a sedan driving northbound on Duval St. had struck the bicycle in the road and propelled it northbound in the travel lane.

When I looked at the noise Torres jumped up to his feet and fled from me northbound on the sidewalk. I aired over Key West COMM1 I was in a foot pursuit. Torres ran towards Officer Grassi and she attempted to grab him while he was running. Torres was able to evade Officer Grassi from grabbing a hold of him.

I ran behind Torres in an attempt to capture him while radioing our updated location to responding units.

Torres, Officer Grassi, Officer Haynie and I gave chase northbound on Duval St. to Caroline St. We ran eastbound on Caroline St. to Anne St., Eastbound on Anne St. and Torres entered the rear entrance of Tattoo's and Scars Saloon. I ran to the front of the establishment attempting to cut off Torres. Torres had already exited the bar and was running eastbound on Greene St. Officer Haynie was still chasing Torres and they ran southbound once they reached Simonton St.

Officer Haynie lost sight of Torres in the pay to park parking lot in the 200 block of Simonton St.

A perimeter was established around the block.

An unknown motorist flagged me down and told me he saw Torres hiding behind a pick up truck in the pay to park parking lot. I searched the area of the north wall in the parking lot and I caught a glimpse of Torres's red pants under a black, Ford F-250 pick up truck between the wall and the truck. Torres did not move. I radioed I had located Torres and gave our location. I acted like I did not see Torres to buy time for the other units to get into position so he may be apprehended.

As the responding units approached the F-250, Torres jumped to his feet and scaled the wall into the ally. I saw Torres was running westbound through the ally and I lost sight of him.

Officer Leahy aired Torres had re-emerged onto Simonton St. and he was running after him. Officer Leahy aired they were running westbound on Greene St. and then northbound on Anne St.

I ran northbound on Simonton St. towards Front St., anticipating Torres was going to run eastbound when they reached Front St.

Officer Leahy aired he and Officer Haynie had deployed their Tasers and Torres was in custody.

I walked to where Torres was apprehended and stood by with the other officers.

I returned to service.

On 07/292018, at approximately 0055 hours, I Officer Leahy responded to the 200 block of Simonton Street to assist in the apprehension of a white male, later identified as Aniel Torres, who had run from police about a battery. Officer Young found Torres hiding under a black pick-up truck within a private parking lot on the 200 block of Simonton Street. Torres emerged from underneath the pick-up truck and climbed over a fence subsequently running back out onto the 200 block of Simonton Street. Both Officer Torreciallas and I pursued Torres on foot, down Greene Street, towards Anne Street. Torres ran down Anne Street towards Front Street. Torres was cut off by K-9 Officer Anglin who was pursuing Torres in his marked K-9 vehicle (activated lights and sirens). Officer Torreciallas had also caught up to Torres. Torres made a quick U-turn on Anne Street and started to run back towards Greene Street. Torres had run into a couple of bystanders, subsequently passing me. I had removed my TASER from my duty belt. Once Torres had cleared the bystanders, I positioned myself directly behind Torres and deployed my TASER. Both probes struck Torres in the center of the back causing muscular incapacitation. Torres fell to the ground. Officer Haynie also deployed his TASER but missed. Officer Haynie's TASER probes struck a brick wall and a wood windowsill of the northwest corner business. Officer Haynie handcuffed Torres. I placed gloves on and subsequently removed both of my TASER probes from Torres' back. Officer Haynie photographed Torres' back. Rescue 2 arrived on scene to evaluate Torres. Torres said he was not injured. Torres refused any medical treatment.

I collected both TASER cartridges and AFIDS, subsequently placing all items into KWPD Property and Evidence as evidence.

I provided both TASERS to Sgt. Rodriguez for downloading.

Sgt. Rodriguez provided me with two CD copies of the TASER videos, which I placed into KWPD Property and Evidence as evidence.

Torres was subsequently transported to the Monroe County Jail by Officer Haynie.

My BWC was activated post TASER deployment.

Officer Haynie's BWC captured my TASER depolyment

The incident was captured on my TASER camera.
