Re: June Monthly Report for Key West Historic Seaport

Key West Bight Operations:

- Working on task order with DN Higgins, under the GU Contract, for refurbishing the main Seaport parking lot.
- Preparing ITB for 2018 Piling Replacement project. Environmental permitting complete.
- Working with the contractor on scheduling the renovation on the Tenant Bathhouse. New shower trailer delivered and installed.
- Task Order with Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, under the General Construction Services Contract, for replacement of the Marina's fire main will be on next month's agenda.
- Task Order with Sea Tech of the Florida Keys, under the General Construction Services Contract, for construction of the ADA restroom at the Schooner Wharf will be on next month's agenda.
- Negotiating task order with Tetra Tech, under the Environmental Services Contract, for coral relocation, final design and bidding and construction services for the seawall repair and/or replacement from Turtle Kraals to Conch Republic.

Key West Bight Marina:

- June transient dockage was down 3 percent compare to last June. Ebsary construction replaced two damage piles one from A dock and the other piles was by lazy lane.
- The Marina is full for lobster mini season from July 23 to July 28 all ready.
- We like to welcome Robert Tipton as our new Dockmaster.
- 12,482 passengers passed through the Ferry Terminal this June compared to 11,505 last June.
- **Wait List.** So far 27 people have returned questionnaires saying they want to remain on the waiting list. 7 people have been called 4 times and have not answered or returned calls. 6 people have disconnected phone numbers. 3 people asked to be removed from the list. Next month we will have a complete report ready with recommendations for the Board.
