Introduction

The City Manager's Office requests the approval of the "Martin Luther King Jr. Birthday Celebration & March" at the Nelson English Park from Noon to 4:00 p.m. and the march from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Background

The City Manager's Office has received an application from "the City of Key West" for the Martin Luther King Birthday Celebration and March on Monday, January 20, 2025, at the Nelson English Park from Noon to 4:00 p.m. - The march will begin at 5:00 p.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m. from the comer of Catherine and Thomas Streets, making a right on Amelia Street, marching down to Duval Street, making a left on Duval Street, proceeding down left on Southard Street, making a left onto Whitehead Street, proceeding all the way down Catherine Street, making a right, where the march will end. Refreshments will be served as well as hot dogs, water, sodas, chips, and cookies. The event will include playing games in the park and utilizing the playground equipment. The applicant has agreed to abide by City Codes and Ordinances, including providing insurance.

Procurement

There will be no additional expenses to the city as all service costs (Police/Fire/Community Services) are covered by the applicant, based on the Special Event Matrix.
