Key West Cemetery

- Met with 39 different families via telephone/email/ in person regarding different inquiries about current burials, new burials, construction permits for new construction and repairs to current structures in family lots, family plot ownership, rights to sell plot, disinterment's and relocating family members, purchase niche or vault.
- 2 full burials, \$1839.20 received in payments for perpetual care, tent and chair rental, casket tray fees.
- 3 burials of cremation, \$ 611.00 received in payment for rental of tent chairs and casket lift rental.
- 3 Niches sold one in Building B, two in Building G mausoleums, two sold for \$1500 One sold for \$2,000.00. Total in niche sales \$5,000.00.
- One vault sold for \$4,000.00 Building F mausoleum.
- Discussed creating signs with scan QR codes to help visitors have access to GIS maps.
- 4 construction permits pulled by families for construction in family lots.
- 15 disinterment done from Chris Varela Mason Lodge Mausoleum along 7th Ave. to relocate to another Mason lodge along 4th Ave.
- One full body disinterment and relocate in same family mausoleum.
- One disinterment of ashes to relocate in same family lot.
- Met with Interim City Manager, Mayor, Legal, Community Services Director to discuss Cemetery operations.
- 5 plaques received by Mathews
- Palm tree in Palm Ave entrance were trimmed and coconuts were removed.
- Palm Memorial mausoleum is still in process of being refurbished by FMT staff.
- Rising Act films got a permit approved by City Manager's office to video tape in Cemetery for the Finish walk of Justin D. Lehew at the USS Main located in the cemetery. Mayor was present to receive Justin D. Lehew.
