A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT TO TALIA SANTIAGO AND LANDON JONES' WEDDING RECEPTION AT THE OLDEST HOUSE 322 DUVAL STREET; PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2024; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS** Talia Santiago and Landon Jones have applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for an event to take place on Saturday, November 9, 2024, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

WHEREAS this event shall take place at the Oldest House – 322 Duval Street.

WHEREAS amplified music will be played during the event.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

**SECTION 1.** That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

**SECTION 2.** "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore

commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

**SECTION 3.** That Talia Santiago and Landon Jones are hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
