A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TETRA TECH, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$81,580.00 FOR SEAWALL ASSESSMENT AND PERMITTING SERVICES FOR THE TURTLE KRAALS SEAWALL REPAIR (PROJECT NO. KB1509); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-359, the City Commission approved a three-year Environmental Engineering Services contract with Tetra Tech, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of December 7, 2016, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended approval of this Task Order; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a Task Order for Seawall Assessment and Permitting Services for the Turtle Kraals Seawall Repair (Project No. KB1509), under the City's Environmental Engineering Services Contract with Tetra Tech, Inc. is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$81,580.00.

Section 2: This project will be funded from account No. 405-7503-575-6300 (KB1509 - Seawall Repairs).

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
