## ORDER IMPOSING LIEN/ AMENDED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

This cause having come before the Special Magistrate on 27 February 2019, pursuant to the Florida Statutes Chapter 162 and Article VI et seq of the Key West Code, and the Special Magistrate having heard sworn testimony, having reviewed the evidence submitted, and being otherwise advised of the premises; The Special Magistrate finds Heron House Court and Marsh Enterprises of SW Florida Inc. are in violation of Key West Code of Ordinances, section(s) 14-37. In that the following condition(s) exists at 412 Frances Street, Key West, FL: Count 1: Failure to obtain a building permit for putting in a new fence.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED:

Imposed is an Administrative Fee of \$250. Also the court imposed a fine of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250) per day for 1 count starting 27 February 2019 until compliance is achieved. All fines and fees are payable within thirty (30) days from the date of this order to the City of Key West, Attn: Code Compliance Division, PO Box 1409, Key West, FL 33041.

2. The Respondent is further ordered to contact the City of Key West Code Inspector to verify compliance, which may include an inspection. Any continuing fine imposed shall continue to accrue until such time as the Code Inspector inspects the property and verifies compliance with this Order. This Order may be recorded in the official records of Monroe County and shall constitute a lien, pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 162.09 (3), for judgment purposes. This case may serve as a predicate for a repeat violation should similar violations occur in the future as applicable.

 If you request that the fine be reduced or mitigated, you must be in compliance and you must request in writing to appear before the Special Magistrate two weeks prior to a hearing to show cause why said fine should be mitigated.

4. Total amount due is \$7,750.00.
