A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 20-216, TO AMEND THE AGREEMENT WITH SYNCROMATICS CORPORATION FOR REAL TIME PASSENGER INFORMATION SYSTEM (RTPI) TO REFLECT AN INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL EXPENDITURE AND AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 08-087, the City Commission awarded a bid for a Real Time Passenger Information system (RTPI) to Syncromatics, Inc., and in Resolution 14-009 the Agreement was renewed for an additional five years; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 20-216 the City Commission approved an additional five-year agreement, retroactive to November 2018 through November 30, 2023, on a sole source basis, to ensure ongoing support, repairs and upgrades as they become available; and

WHEREAS, the City has increased its passenger vehicle inventory from 20 to 24 vehicles, and finds that it would be beneficial to expand the Syncromatic systems agreement to include the additional vehicles at additional cost; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Resolution 20-016 is hereby amended to adjust the quantity of vehicles, and the annual expenditure for Syncromatics RTPI systems, pursuant to section 2-797(1) of the Code of Ordinances. (The annual expenditure for FY 22 is increased from \$42,654.21 to \$49,779.79 and for FY 23, the expenditure will be adjusted from \$49,779.79 to \$50,775.39, including the contractual 2% increase.)

Section 2: That this expenditure is budgeted for FY 22 in Transit Cost Centers 411-4402-544-41 (City Routes), 411-4405-544-41 (Lower Keys Shuttle), and 411-4407-544-41 (Duval Loop), and any necessary transfers or adjustments area hereby approved. Funding requests for FY23 will be submitted during the regular budget process.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
