A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION 21-246 TO ALLOW THE MONROE COUNTY COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN, INC. 16TH ANNUAL FLORIDA KEYS SEAFOOD FESTIVAL AT BAYVIEW PARK A CHANGE OF DATES FROM SATURDAY, JANUARY 15th, 2022 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M. AND SUNDAY, JANUARY 16th, 2022 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M TO APRIL 2, 2022 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M. AND SUNDAY. APRIL 3, 2022 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. (SET UP THURSDAY, AND FRIDAY, MARCH 31 & APRIL 1, 2022); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE MANAGER: **AUTHORIZING** THE SALE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE **ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen Inc. has pledged that a 100 percentage of the monies raised at this event will go toward scholarships to be awarded to the children of fishermen or his/her family who excel academically.

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen, Inc. wishes to change the date of the event from January 15th and 16th, 2022 to April 2 & 3, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are

neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen's, Inc is hereby granted permission to conduct a Seafood Festival on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Monroe County Commercial Fishermen, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Monroe County Commercial Fishermen's, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That the Monroe County Fishermen, Inc will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, and that (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by this Commission, or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the Community.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and
adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the
Commission.
