A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY" BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH FLORIDA/COLLEGE OF MARINE SCIENCE (USF) FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A CODAR OCEAN CURRENT MONITORING STATION (OCMS) AT THE EASTERN END OF SMATHERS BEACH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the University of South Florida has requested to use a small piece of Smathers Beach for installation of an Ocean Current Monitoring System (OCMS), including a tapered marine mast antenna and electronics enclosure, as part of their Coastal Ocean Monitoring and Prediction System (COMPS); and

WHEREAS, the proposed installation site is within the vegetation area close to the eastern end of Smathers Beach, not within the area travelled by those that use the beach, and, if approved, all permits will be applied for by USF; and

WHEREAS, the COMPS system will provide real-time data for emergency management use, and serve the scientific community and the public at no additional cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that allowing USF to install and maintain an OCMS on City property at Smathers Beach, would provide a benefit to residents of Key West and the United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY" between the City and USF for installation and maintenance of an OCMS, upon specific terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
