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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST (CITY) APPROVING CHANGE ORDER #2 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$160,029.11 FOR UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS, AND AUTHORIZING A TIME EXTENSION UNDER THE CONTRACT AWARDED TO CHARLEY TOPPINO AND SONS, INC. FOR ITB #21-009, WHITEHEAD AND FRONT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS AND AMENDMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTE MANAGER TO NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 21-058, the City Commission approved an interlocal agreement with the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (FKAA) to incorporate the replacement of a water main, the cost of which FKAA will reimburse to the City, with the roadway rehabilitation project set forth in ITB #21-009; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 21-113 a contract was awarded to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. for Whitehead and Front Improvements Project, in response to ITB #21-009; and

WHEREAS, unforeseen conditions were encountered with respect to the water main installation, resulting in \$160,029.11 in additional labor and equipment time, most of which (\$150,332.36) will be reimbursed by FKAA; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COMMISSION OF THE Page 1 of 3

CITY OF KEY WEST, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$160,029.11 for additional work and including a 42-day time extension required for unforeseen conditions, under the contract awarded to Charley Toppino and Sons, Inc. (ITB 21-009) in Resolution 21-113, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funds for the project are allocated in account #102-4102-541-6300 (Internal Improvements/Gas Tax), Project #II41022002, Purchase Order #94266. Additional reimbursement of up to \$150,332.36 is anticipated from FKAA, pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement approved in Resolution 21-058. Any necessary budget transfers or amendments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute documents related to this Change Order, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.
