Experience the 'somewhat' historical reenactments, including the "Raising of the Conch Republic Colors & Opening Ceremony" (April 15,) and the April 23 INDEPENDENCE DAY Ceremony (both at Mallory Square.)

These events bring Island Dignitaries, Conch Republic (CR) Military members, Conch-Stituants, and visitors together to pay homage to the Founders of the Conch Republic, to salute the CR Flag, recite the CR Pledge Allegiance, and sing the CR Battle Hymn.

Not to be missed, is the Great Sea Battle of the CR, or as First Sea Lord, ADM Finbar says, "War done right."

Taking place on April 22, in, alongside, and over Key West Harbor, this "All in FUN" spectacular battle at sea, pits a United States Coast Guard Ship against the mighty forces of CR Military Forces.

And like the first Sea Battle of the CR in 1982, fought with water cannons, Cuban bread, Conch fritters, and most importantly, Humor.
