**SUBJECT:** Awarding the Proposal to Paul Findlay, Island City Tennis, for RFP 22-002 for Tennis Professional Services

**ACTION STATEMENT:** Resolution Accepting the Highest Ranking Proposal of Paul Findlay, Island City Tennis for Tennis Professional Services and authorizing the City Manager to enter a contract per the provisions of RFP 22-002.

**BACKGROUND:** The City of Key West solicited proposals through a publicly noticed RFP 22-002 for Tennis Professional Services. The proposal was opened in the City Clerk's Office on February 23, 2022. The City of Key West received 2 proposals. One from Paul Findlay, Island City Tennis, and another from Tomas Gattermayer, Sunshine State Tennis Academy LLC. A ranking committee was publicly noticed and held on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The ranking committee ranked as follows:

Paul Findaly, Island City Tennis- 3115 Total Points

Tomas Gattermayer, Sunshine State Academy LLC- 1865 Total Points

**PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION:** The City recognizes the need for quality tennis professional services to provide instruction and maintenance at the Bayview Park tennis pro shop and courts.

**STRATEGIC PLAN:** Awarding the Proposal to Paul Findlay, Island City Tennis, is consistent with the Key West Forward Strategic Plan, Priority 5: Cleanliness.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** As per the proposal Paul Findlay, Island City Tennis, will pay a monthly sum of \$500 to the City of Key West.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Staff recommends approval of the ranking of the proposals from RFP 22-002 and Authorizing the City Manager to enter a contract with Paul Findaly, Island City Tennis.
