










Location: 60% (growing in rear yard area between two parcels, application states that the tree is growing into sewer line but no documentation submitted. Where is the sewer line for the property?) Species: 100% (on protected tree list) Condition: 40% (overall condition is poor, tree has evidence of termites and a fungal growth near base of tree that indicates decay wood) Total Average Value = 66% Value x Diameter = 13.3 replacement caliper inches
