

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST BUSINESS GUILD, INC. TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL HEADDRESS BALL AT THE TRUMAN WATERFRONT COFFEE BUTLER AMPHITHEATRE ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2022 FROM 6:30 P.M. TO 11:30 P.M.; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Key West Business Guild, Inc. wishes to conduct their Annual Headdress Ball” at Truman Waterfront Coffee Butler Amphitheatre between the hours of 6:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 27, 2022; and

WHEREAS this event shall take place on the grounds of the Truman Waterfront Amphitheatre between the hours of 6:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on October 27th, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law.”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor

therefore commits to refrain from the use of distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

SECTION 3. That the Key West Business Guild, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct their “Annual Headdress Ball” on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, the Key West Business Guild, LLC is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Business Guild must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. the Key West Business Guild, Inc. will be responsible for the rental fee of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars plus tax as well as any other cost associated with the event, including Police Security, Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 7. the Key West Business Guild, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used that and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 8. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the community.

SECTION 9. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
