On Thursday, February 24, 2022, at approximately 2200 hours, I (Officer M. Brable) was on routine patrol of 400 block of Caroline St. I observed a male subject laying on the sidewalk in front of a bus stop.

I stopped my patrol vehicle and told the subject (later identified as Brian Jenkins) to get up from the sidewalk and sit on the bench. Jenkins waved his arm and disregarded my request. I parked my patrol vehicle and approached Jenkins. Jenkins cooperated, got up and sat on the bench.

Officer A. Litton arrived on the scene and informed me, Jenkins was moved along after obstructing the sidewalk in front of 216 Duval St, earlier tonight. Officer Litton added, Jenkins was issued a warning and educated on the Municipal Ordinance. Jenkins was issued the warning on 02/24/2022 at 2110 hours, CAD number 220550172.

As Officer Litton and I walked away, Jenkins laid down on the sidewalk again, placed a backpack under his head and was going to light a cigarette. I observed a male and a female couple avoiding Jenkins and were forced to step into the roadway to avoid Jenkins and to continue their journey down the sidewalk.

I believed another warning would not help the situation. Based on his actions, I believed there was a probable cause for Jenkins' arrest for violation of Municipal Ordinance MOV 62-2 OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY. I told Jenkins to stand up and Officer Litton and I placed him in handcuffs. Officer Litton and I used two sets of handcuffs due to Jenkins' size.

I walked Jenkins to my patrol vehicle and asked him to face the vehicle so I could conduct a search incident to arrest. Jenkins said, "I aint facing shit, make me". Jenkins faced the vehicle and a I conducted the search. When I asked Jenkins to have a seat in my vehicle he refused. Jenkins tensed up and would not move. I was able to get most of his body into the vehicle, but once inside, Jenkins laid down on the seat and we were unable to get his legs in. I pulled Jenkins out of the vehicle to start over. Once I got Jenkins out, I noticed a laceration on his left eyebrow. It was unknow, if Jenkins suffered the laceration while trying to get Jenkins in the vehicle, or while I pulled him back out to reposition his legs. Jenkins alleged I punched him in the face, which I did not.

Once Officer Litton and I got Jenkins out of the vehicle, Jenkins laid down on the road and would not move. Jenkins said, "You asked for it". I picked Jenkins up and managed to have him sit down in the back seat. Jenkins would not get his legs inside of the vehicle. Jenkins was tensed up and refused to get his legs into the vehicle. I struck Jenkins twice in his quadriceps with a closed fist to gain pain compliance and to bend Jenkins' knees and get his feet inside. I was not successful. Officer Litton utilize his AXON Taser and, after a warning, drive stunned Jenkins to gain pain compliance. Jenkins eventually complied and got his feet inside of the vehicle.

Officer Litton notified Sergeant J. Hammer of the Taser usage and requested for Sergeant Hammers to respond to the scene.

Sergeant Hammers arrived on the scene and spoke with Jenkins. Jenkins refused medical attention.

In addition to violation of MOV 62-2 OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY, Jenkins was charged with violation of F.S.S. 843.02 RESIST / OBSTRUCT OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE - by refusing to comply with my lawful orders to the inside of the patrol vehicle.

My AXON body worn camera was activated.

On 02/24/2022 at approximately 2200 hours, I (Ofc. A. Litton) responded to the 400 block of Caroline Street to assist Officer M. Brable with an intoxicated subject.

When I arrived, I immediately recognized Brian Jenkins, who Officer M. Brablc informed me was laying across the sidewalk when he arrived. I informed Officer M. Brablc that I contacted Jenkins at 216 Duval Street earlier that night, where I gave him a warning for obstructing the sidewalk (CAD 220550172). Officer M. Brablc and I walked away from Jenkins after he told Officer M. Brablc he was waiting for the bus to arrive. As we stood on the sidewalk by our patrol vehicles, Jenkins laid down on the ground and attempted to go back to sleep. Jenkins laid perpendicular to the street, obstructing the entire sidewalk, inhibiting anyone from passing without stepping over him or walking into the street. A couple then walked up to Jenkins and was forced to walk into the street, stepping in front of a passing vehicle, so they could continue up the sidewalk.

Officer M. Brable and I walked over to Jenkins and placed him in handcuffs for obstructing the sidewalk. We walked Jenkins to Officer M. Brable's patrol vehicle where he was searched and told to sit in the back seat. Jenkins was defiant, difficult, and confrontational during the entire encounter. Jenkins did not willingly sit inside the vehicle, so Officer M. Brable attempted to coerce Jenkins' head down and body inside the vehicle. Jenkins proceeded to tense his body, making it difficult to place him in the vehicle. Jenkins eventually fell into the back seat, leaving his body tense with his feet outside of the vehicle, refusing to sit inside. Officer M. Brable then attempted to remove Jenkins from the patrol vehicle so he could sit properly inside. Jenkins kept his body straight and forced his head against the top of the door jamb so he could not come out of the vehicle.

Jenkins was removed from the vehicle and stood outside the door as I adjusted the handcuffs and assured they were double locked. Jenkins then collapsed to the ground, forcing Officer M. Brable and I to pick him up and attempt to place his 6'4", 300 plus pound body into the back seat of the patrol vehicle. We managed to place Jenkins in the back seat but he, again, offered active resistance, using his large size and stature to defy commands to place his legs inside the vehicle. Officer M. Brable gave ample commands to Jenkins to place his legs inside the vehicle and attempted to obtain pain compliance through the use of strikes to Jenkin's common peroneal nerve on his right thigh, but the strikes had no effect. As Officer M. Brable continued to attempt to use force to place Jenkins in the patrol vehicle, I removed my department issued Taser from its holster, removed the cartridge, and placed the Taser against the right side of Jenkins' abdomen. I gave verbal commands for Jenkins to place his legs inside the vehicle or he would be drive-stunned. Jenkins continued to offer active resistance and I delivered a single cycle drive-stun to the side of Jenkins' body. Jenkins immediately complied and placed his legs inside the vehicle.

I notified Sergeant J. Hammers to respond to the scene for the response to resistance incident report. Jenkins refused any medical treatment and was transported by Officer M. Brable to MCDC without further incident. Axon BWC was
