NARCOTICS ARREST/ RESPONSE TO RESISTANCE INCIDENT

On Friday, 03/04/22, at approximately 0349hrs, I (Ofc. T. Clark), while on routine patrol of 3700 N. Roosevelt Blvd, Exxon "Uppys", observed a suspicious person, sitting in front of the closed business.

I was in full KWPD uniform in a marked KWPD patrol vehicle.

The property is posted with signs authorizing KWPD with permissions to trespass warn and remove subjects. Recently, this area has been subject to complaint, reference trespassers on the property at night.

On approach of the subject, later identified by name and DOB as, Austin Shelly 03/13/99, I could smell the strong odor of freshly burning marijuana. Austin appeared nervous by my approach.

Austin was seated on the ground and quickly began shoving what appeared to be a glass smoking pipe into a back pack in front of him. I began to tell Austin my observations. Austin then told me he was leaving. Austin then began to stand and grab his belongings. I gave Austin several lawful commands to have a seat, activating my BWC.

Austin disobeyed my lawful commands to have a seat and quickly began to actively physical resist, by fleeing my investigation. Austin ran through the parking lot and I chased him.

I deployed my department issued TASER (S/N X1200CRW6). The darts made contact with Austins back and the device achieved full Neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI). As Austin was fleeing and NMI was achieved he fell down into the parking lot pavement.

Austin then attempted to beg me not to arrest him. Austin was issued several lawful commands to place his hands behind his back, in which he ignored, attempting to negotiate. Austin finally obeyed, placing his hands behind his back. I then placed Austin under arrest.

During the course of placing Austin under arrest, he issued numerous spontaneous utterances, which were, but not limited to:

"I'm going through alot and I was just getting high"

"All I got is some weed, some Xanax"

"Please don't take me to jail"

Sgt A. Rodriguez responded to the scene to complete a Response to Resistance Incident Report. Ofc. R. Roscoe and Ofc. M. Hansell responded as back up Officer's.

Austin claimed pain to his right thumb from his fall (dislocated). Austin did not claim any further injury.

Upon search of Austin's back pack, I located the following items:

x 2 glass smoking pipes, one appeared to be bulbous, had a burned residue and used for smoking the narcotic Metahamphetamine (no other legitimate purpose, known to me from experience). The other glass smoking pipe contained a burned residue, and smelled strongly of freshly burned marijuana.

- x 1 clear plastic baggie, containing a clear rock like substance (later FTP Methamphetamine 2.1 grams).
- x21 white rectangular shaped Xanax pills (identified by Ofc. M. Hansell). No prescription.
- x5 Orange oval shaped Amphetamine 30mg pills (identified by Ofc. M. Hansell). No prescription.
- x1 baggie, 4.1 grams of FTP Marijuana.
- x1 digital scale.

KWPD EMS responded to the scene.

I transported Austin to LKMC ER for treatment (dislocated thumb). Once treated I transported Austin to MCDC.

Ofc. M. Hansell submitted my expended TASER cartridge, the suspected narcotics and their paraphernalia into KWPD Evidence.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Austin with the following:

x1 count, FSS 843.02, Resisting Without Violence, for willfully and actively resisting my lawful investigation, by disobeying my lawful commands to sit, for fleeing from me (full KWPD uniform), for refusing to place his hands behind his back after receiving verbal commands.

x3 count, FSS 893.13(6)(A), Possession of a Controlled Substance, for being in possession without a prescription of 21 Xanax pills (1 count), 5 Amphetamine pills (1 count) and 2.1 grams of FTP Methamphetamine (1 count), Located in his back pack.

x1 count, FSS 893.13(6)(B), Possession of Marijuana under 20 grams (no Medical Card), for the FTP Marijuana 4.1 grams. Located in his back pack.

x1 count, FSS 893.147(1), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, for the glass smoking pipes, with their burned residue, clearly identifiable to me from training and experience to serve no other legitimate purpose but for smoking narcotics. One pipe for Marijuana and one pipe for Methamphetamine. Located in his back pack.
