On 3/19/2022 at 0439 hours, I (Ofc. Roy Owens) and Ofc. N. Howell were dispatched to 414 Virginia St. in reference to a verbal disturbance.

Upon arrival, I met with Phillip West, who told me he was trying to get his food from the residence. Ofc. Howell informed me that West had threatened his mother earlier in the day. West rambled and did not make sense when asked basic questions. I asked West about why we were called to the residence for this incident, and he continued to ramble about various subjects. Ashley James, the girlfriend of West stated West has not properly taken his medications for the past few months.

It was my belief that without proper care and treatment West posed an imminent threat of bodily harm to himself or to his family members in the near future, as evidence of recent behavior. Ofc. Howell and I attempted to Baker Act West, and he began to resist. After West was placed in handcuffs, we began escorting him to the car. West dropped down to the ground crying becoming dead weight. Ofc. Howell and I grabbed West under his arms and carried him to the patrol car. West continued to resist. West stated he would swallow his gold teeth to kill himself. I told West multiple times to spit out his gold in color teeth and not to swallow them. West stated multiple time he would kill Ofc. Howell, Ofc. Bozetti and myself. West increased his level of resistance and began kicking his feet and pulling away. West was given multiple clear verbal commands to stop resisting, however, he refused to comply. Ofc. Howell and I placed West on the ground, and he continued to resist.

West's feet were restrained in a hobble. When Ofc. Howell and I tried to put West into the back seat of the patrol car he kicked the door and dented the rear driver's side door. West also kicked the front driver's door and dented it near the door handle. West stated he was injured on his head; shoulder and stated he couldn't feel his legs. I requested EMS on scene as well as the shift SGT for a response to resistance incident. Key West Rescue 2 arrived on scene to assess West's injuries. West refused treatment by EMS and became increasingly resistant. SGT Hammers arrived on scene to document the response to resistance incident.

West was eventually placed in the back seat of the patrol car. I activated the in car COBAN system at this time. While in the vehicle West continued to remove his seat belt. West banged his head against the window multiple times and proceeded to kick the inside of the passenger rear door. I opened the passenger side door to re-apply the seat belt and West attempted to get out of the vehicle. I regained control of West and placed him back in the patrol vehicle. West continued to show increased resistance, refusing to comply with officer's orders. SGT Hammers and I removed West from the vehicle to re-apply a set of hobbles and attach them through the front seat area. West sustained minor abrasions to his arms and legs during this incident. SGT Hammers was notified and arrived on scene to document the response to resistance incident.

I transported West to MCDC without further incident.

The damage to the patrol vehicle is approximately \$1500.00. I took photographs of the damage and uploaded them to EVIDENCE.com.

Since West willfully and maliciously damaged property belonging to another, and the damage is estimated at \$1000.00 or greater he was in violation of F.S.S. 806.13-1b3.

Since West resisted officers during the execution of their duties, he was in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

On 03/19/2022, around 04:40 hours, I (Ofc. Bozzetti) Ofc. Howell and Ofc. Owens were dispatched to 414 Virginia St., reference a verbal disturbance.

On arrival, we spoke with an involved male, later identified as Phillip West. After investigating the incident, Ofc. Owens and Ofc. Howell attempted to take West into protective custody under the Baker Act. After West was placed into handcuffs he began resisting and pulling away from Ofc. Howell and Ofc. Owens. West stopped walking, fell to the ground, and began flopping around. West was doing whatever he could to stop us from gaining control of him and placing him in the rear seat of the vehicle. We placed West's feet in a hobble and eventually gained enough control of him to be able to place him in the backseat of the vehicle. While Ofc. Owens and Ofc. Howell were escorting West to the backseat of the vehicle, West kicked Ofc. Owens' car twice. West's kicks created 2 large dents on Ofc. Owens' car.

Once he was in the back seat of the vehicle, he continued to act erratically and began kicking the inside of the vehicle. I assisted Sgt. Hammers in securing the hobble to the vehicle, so that West could not continue to kick the inside of the vehicle.

Once West was safely secured inside the vehicle, Ofc. Owens transported him to the MCDC.

West sustained minor abrasions to his arms and legs. West had a gold grill on his bottom teeth which cut his gums, causing him to bleed from his mouth. He also complained of shoulder pain. KWFD Rescue arrived on scene to medically evaluate West, however, West refused in medical treatment.

This was the end of my involvement in this case.

My BWC was activated during this incident.

On Saturday, 03/19/2022 at approximately 0437 hours; Ofc. Bozzetti, Probationary Ofc. Owens, and I (Ofc. Howell) were dispatched to 414 Virginia Street regarding a potential suspicious incident.

I arrived on scene first and encountered an unknown black male subject walking eastbound on the 400-Block of Virginia Street, toward Duval Street. The unknown black male subject appeared to be extremely flustered and possibly under the influence of alcohol and/or narcotics. Shortly afterward, Ofc. Bozzetti and Probationary Ofc. Owens arrived on scene. The unknown black male subject provided Probationary Ofc. Owens his name, Phillip N. West (DOB: 07/07/1991, Arrestee). Probationary Ofc. Owens continued to attempt to speak with West. At this point, West's mother and ex-girlfriend arrived on scene. I stepped away to speak to West's mother and ex-girlfriend.

West's mother and ex-girlfriend explained that West is supposed to take medication however, he has failed to in at least a few weeks. West's mother informed me that West threatened her earlier in the day, 03/19/2022. West's ex-girlfriend informed me that West also threatened her and their children earlier in the day as well, 03/19/2022. After speaking at length with West's mother and ex-girlfriend, I spoke with Probationary Ofc. Owens and we decided that West met the requirements for a Baker Act.

Probationary Ofc. Owens and I placed West in handcuffs. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I took West into protective custody. West immediately became aggressive and began attempting to pull away from Probationary Ofc. Owens and me. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I quickly gained control of West and walked him to Probationary Ofc. Owens' patrol vehicle. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I attempted to searched West subsequent to arrest. West again became aggressive and attempted to pull away Probationary Ofc. Owens and me. West began attempting to headbutt Probationary Ofc. Owens. Probationary Ofc. Owens moved away and West dropped to the ground. West rolled over on his back and continuously attempted to kick Probationary Ofc. Owens and me. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I once again gained control of West and brought West to his feet. West suddenly and swiftly attempted to kick me. Due to West's actions and level of resistance rising, I placed West in an arm bar and placed West's upper body on the hood of Probationary Ofc. Owens' patrol vehicle in a controlled manner. After a few minutes, West stated he was calm. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I attempted to place West in rear seat of Probationary Ofc. Owens' patrol vehicle. West again suddenly and swiftly pulled away while kicking Probationary Ofc. Owens patrol vehicle twice. At this point, due to West's actions and his level of resistance rising Probationary Ofc. Owens performed a takedown and placed West on the ground in a controlled manner. Ofc. Bozzetti, Probationary Ofc. Owens, and I hobbled West's ankles. Probationary Ofc. Owens and I placed West in the rear seat of Probationary Ofc. Owens' patrol vehicle several times. West continuously headbutted the plexiglass divider and glass windows. West continuously attempted to kick out the rear glass windows several times, as well.

West sustained minor abrasions on his left arm, near his elbow, as well on the back side of his head due to his

West sustained minor lacerations to the inside of his mouth while attempting to swallow and bite down on his removable, yellow-colored dental jewelry. West had a small amount of blood dripping from the corners of his mouth. West refused medical attention from Key West Fire/Rescue on scene several times.

West appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. West's speech was slurred, and his eyes were glassy and bloodshot. West's breath had the odor of alcoholic intoxicants. West appeared to be under the influence of narcotics. West's speech was incoherent and unintelligible at times. West's pupils were contracted, and his eyes were bloodshot. West's balance was impaired to the point that he occasionally stumbled while walking.

My BWC was activated for the encounter, arrest, takedowns, and subsequent search of West. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.
