-- Poor Joshua Aaron Arrest Narrative:

On March 27, 2022, at approximately 0300 hours I, Officer Agleev, was flagged down on Duval Street, reference a passed-out person in front of 129 Duval Street.

Upon arrival to the above-mentioned address, I observed a white male, later identified as Joshua Poor (Arrestee), passed out partially blocking the sidewalk in front of a business store. Poor had a backpack under his head, and deep asleep.

I asked Poor to sit up and speak with me. I advised Poor, it was a city ordinance violation to sleep on a sidewalk, and block pedestrian traffic. I asked Poor to sit up and provide me with his ID. I offered Poor my hand to help him sit up. Poor grabbed my hand but refused to sit up. Poor continuously refused to identify himself. I ordered Poor to place the hands behind the back and grabbed his arm. Poor strongly pulled away and attempted to kick me. I got on my radio and requested a back-up unit. Poor stood up and told me to get away from him. I displayed my TASER device and advised Poor he could get tased for aggressive resisting. I ordered Poor to sit down. I holstered my TASER and advised Dispatch about TASER display.

While I was talking on my radio, Poor raised his hands, clutched his fists, and started approaching me, while yelling profanities. I made two steps back and stopped. Poor stepped towards me, grabbed my arms, and pushed me. Poor attempted to swing at me. I raised my both arms protecting myself from Poor's advances. I grabbed Poor with both arms, pulled him towards me, and redirected him to the ground. Officer Torrecillas, Officer R. Perez, and a security guard from Rick's Bar (see Officer Torrecillas' supplemental report) assisted me with handcuffing Poor. While on the ground Poor continued pulling away and rotating his body.

I handcuffed Poor behind his back, Officer Waite placed hobble device on Poor's legs. I placed Poor into my patrol vehicle. Poor's California and Texas State IDs were recovered from his backpack during the search, incident to arrest.

Sergeants Sims and Conaty responded to the scene and talked to Poor, reference a Respond to Resistance Incident. Poor did not need any medical attention.

I transported Poor to the Monroe County Detention Center. MCDC deputies advised, Poor had previous arrests from 4 different states. The charges included grand theft and aggravated assault.

Based on the facts and evidence I believe there is probable cause that Joshua Poor on 03/27/2022 did violate F.S.S. 784.07(2)(b), when he knowingly and intentionally kicked me, grabbed my arms, and pushed me, while I was in the lawful execution of my legal duty.

Based on the facts and evidence I believe there is probable cause that Joshua Poor on 03/27/2022 did knowingly and intentionally grabbed my arms and pushed me, Officer Agleev, while I was in the lawful execution of my legal duty. Poor violate F.S.S. 843.01, Resisting an Officer with Violence.

Based on facts and evidence I believe there is probable cause, that Joshua Poor on 03/27/2022 did violate F.S.S. 843.02, Resisting an Officer without Violence by:

1. resisting me by twisting his body and pulling away his arms, while attempting to break my efforts to handcuff

On March 27, 2022, at approximately 0313 hours, I, Officer J. Torrecillas responded to 129 Duval St. as a backup officer to Officer D. Agleev.

Upon arrival, I saw Joshua Poor (arrestee), advancing forward towards Ofc. Agleev. Ofc. Agleev placed his hand on Poor's chest to back him off. Poor forcefully pushed Ofc. Agleev. Ofc. Agleev grabbed Poor, and Poor began fighting by grabbing Ofc. Agleev.

I exited my patrol car and grabbed Poor. Poor continued fighting and Ofc. Agleev and I took Poor to the ground. Poor continued resisting once on the ground by not letting go of Ofc. Agleev and kicking his legs continuously. I grabbed Poor's legs to control his legs and stop him from kicking. Ofc. Agleev controlled Poor's upper body as I maintained control of his legs.

Joshua Blake (witness) arrived, as well as another bystander (unidentified), and assisted us in rolling poor onto his stomach so we could handcuff him.

Officer R. Perez arrived on scene and retrieved a hobble. Ofc. Perez and I applied the hobble to Poor's legs.

Blake provided me with a sworn written statement. In his statement, Blake stated the following: He was working the front door of Rick's Bar when he saw Poor fighting with Ofc. Agleev and me. He went to the incident location and assisted us by holding Poor down. Once Poor was secured, he returned to work.

See Blake's written statement form for further information.

I attempted to activate my BWC as I exited my patrol car but after further review, realized my BWC was activated after Poor was handcuffed. Both Ofc. Agleev and my BWC's were knocked off during the incident. My BWC video was uploaded to Evidence.com.

Ofc. Agleev provided Blake with a Key West Police business card with a case number. I submitted Blake's written statement to the Key West Police Department Records Department.

On 03/27/2022, at 0311 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was dispatched to 129 Duval St. in reference to an intoxicated subject. While in route I heard Ofc. Agleev ask for back up.

Upon arrival I saw Ofc. Agleev, Ofc. Torrecillas, and two bystanders trying to detain a male on the ground. The male was later identified by his California DL as Joshua Poor. I ran toward the group and told one of the bystanders to allow me to assist. The bystander moved and I placed my left knee on Poor's buttocks to assist with holding him down. Ofc. Agleev was able to pry Poor's left hand out from under him. I held Poor's left hand until Ofc. Agleev was able to pry Poor's right hand free and place them in handcuffs. I told Ofc. Torrecillas that I was going to grab a hobble. I got up ran toward my vehicle and grabbed my hobble. We placed the hobble on Poor's legs and tied the hobble. Poor was then placed in the back of Ofc. Agleev's Patrol vehicle.

My AXON BWC was activated after we gained control of Poor.
