A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE BID OF CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #22-003 FOR SOUTHARD STREET MILLING AND RESURFACING (PROJECT FM435497-2-58/II41022102) IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,094,457.85; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS AND AMENDMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Southard Street Milling and Resurfacing project (Southard Street from Duval to Thomas Street) is part of the Bahama Village Connectivity Project, funded up to 80% by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Agency Program (LAP); and

WHEREAS, one bid was received in response to ITB 22-003, with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. submitting the sole responsive bid, and FDOT provided concurrence to award a contract to Charley Toppino & Sons; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds the bid to be responsive and responsible, and recommends award of the bid to Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. is hereby awarded in response to ITB 22-003 for Southard Street Milling and Resurfacing, in an amount not to exceed \$1,094,457.85.

Section 2: That the project is funded in account 102-4102-541-6300 (Gas Tax/Internal Improvements), Project II41022102. Reimbursement of construction costs up to \$937,462.00 is anticipated through the FDOT LAP Program Federal Highway Administration funding. Any additional necessary budget adjustments or amendments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
