WHEREAS, the Half Shell Raw Bar will continue its long history of supporting

local charities, by hosting a "50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Seafood Festival" on August 27<sup>th</sup>, to benefit the Cancer Foundation of the Florida Keys;

and

WHEREAS, the City Commission urges residents and visitors alike to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup>

Anniversary of the Half Shell Raw Bar.
