# Code Case 22-00668 Non-Permitted Work – Envy Pools Heather Tidwell

## **Officer Slecton Timeline**

4/7/2022

During an owner applicant permit inspection I observed and photographed non-permitted work that had already been performed (digging of a pool). No one was onsite actively working on this project but I was able to determine that ASAP Pools performed the work as a sub-contractor for the permit qualifier Envy Pools, without the benefit of the required permit. Building Permit BLD2022-0405 Pool has been applied for but is currently at "Information Required" status therefore has not been paid for nor posted. Owners of record are Wacker Michael Frederick and Peila John Christopher PO Box 398, Miles City MT 59301. I opened a code case, placed photos in File Bound and Body Cam video has been stored in Evidence.

4/7/2022

I spoke to the owner of the subject address regarding the non-permitted work performed and he stated that he spoke to Jorge from ASAP Pools earlier today and was told that the permit is in place and the hole is dug. I told him that Envy Pools applied for the permit and he said he may have the wrong name but was pretty sure it was ASAP. I explained that I would be placing a Stop Work Order at his property and what needed to be done next.

4/7/2022

I spoke to the owner of Envy Pools Heather Tidwell who told me that she did not perform any work at the subject address and had planned to name ASAP Pools as the subcontractor for this project. She said if there are any issues it was done by ASAP and that she was going to call Jorge and find out what happened.

4/7/2022

I spoke to Jorge the owner of ASAP Pools and he said that they did the non-permitted work because he thought Heather at Envy had the permit in place and it was her fault if it isn't done. He also confirmed that he was being hired as a subcontractor for this project and was waiting over 2 months to get started. I asked if he is a licensed contractor and he said no because he works under Envy's license.

4/13/2022

The owner of Envy Pools came to City Hall and obtained the required permit to resume work on the pool installation but has not been clear as to who is performing the work. I spoke to her again and she now states that ASAP pools is being brought in as labor only and not as a subcontractor. I asked if they were on her payroll, and she said no they are being paid as laborers. I informed her that A.S.A.P. Pool and Spa Services was licensed as a mobile pool cleaning company her hiring them qualifies as unlicensed contractors performing the work. She strongly disagreed.

4/29/2022

I conducted a follow up inspection and found that Envy pools was using licensed workers to complete the work being performed. The workers said they worked for Envy Pools.

4/29/2022

Code case CLOSED
