

Notes from Bayview Park Community Workshop- December 7th, 2022

1. Green spaces-Keep the open spaces
2. Solar screens to block the morning sun while tennis players are active
3. Keep everything as natural as possible/natural look
4. Separate playground for younger children
5. Resident "Manager" to maintain the park
6. Bocce courts in the dead space behind the double tennis courts
7. 4 ft. Fence around the park
8. Putt Putt golf in the dead space and expanding along the edges of the park for children
9. Sitting stones that are large and flat for people to sit/lay on
10. Meditation Zone/QR Code to guide those that want to use that service
11. Signage that is more inviting/friendly instead of:
 - a. "NO X"
 - b. "NO Y"
 - c. "NO Z"
12. Add a "Key West Baseball Hall of Fame" informational board to the inside and the outside fences of the field.
13. Pickle ball courts possibly in "dead zone"
14. Solar Screen or some kind of netting to prevent stray softballs and baseballs from impeding on the tennis courts
15. Solar Panels for lighting in the area
16. Water connection should be above ground, not below
17. Possibly a community garden in the "dead Zone"
18. Bathrooms relocated to be connected to the new pro shop building-access to bathrooms still on the outside
19. A community center for people to gather
20. Artificial Fields and rotate field alignment so the press box/in field is on Georgia Street
21. Open space at the bottom of the bathroom doors to prevent people from making a "studio apartment" inside a stall
22. More Outdoor learning
23. Walking track with a soft/squishy surface
24. Integrate sensory items in park/more options for those with special needs
25. Bring back Friday night movies
26. Livestream camera on the courts to see if they are "dry" so people can check them prior to going to the park
27. Security Cameras around the park
28. New Garbage and Recycling bins
29. Park is currently "filthy"
30. Historic Signage
31. Make the park easy to maintain
32. Concern for Chickens and the upkeep from their destruction
33. Bring in more live music that is not too incredibly loud (steel pan drums, ukulele, calmer music)

34. Free Library box
35. Make Virginia Street a greenway for only pedestrian and bicycle traffic: Jose Marti-Windsor
36. Gang up toilets to make less private-for discouraging homeless.
