Notes from Bayview Park Community meeting

Concerns:

- 1. Concern: If we move the double tennis courts, the new ones will take a "long time" to settlesometimes even years. "We shouldn't move the courts, leave them on the current foundation and maybe just resurface.
- 2. Concern: "I work with kids every day and sidewalks are a big tripping hazard. It needs to be all grass".
- 3. Concern: "Previously an employee attempted to locate the irrigation system and dug big holes. Then they just filled them. We need a new irrigation system. "
- 4. Concern: Yan will go out of business if we move the double tennis courts
- 5. Concern: When we resurface or move the tennis courts, Yan will have to move to the other courts and take up two of the public courts for instructing.
- 6. Concern: The events will no longer have the space to continue
- 7. Concern: Where will all the data and surveys be available for the public?
- 8. Concern: How are we recording everything and maintaining all the concerns and requests?

## Wants:

- 1. Wants: More bike racks near the courts
- 2. Wants: More seating by the triple courts
- 3. Wants: More shade treed instead of hard structures providing shade
- 4. Wants: Smaller bathrooms/larger bathrooms
- 5. Wants: "move the courts closer to Truman and have a better use for the wasted green space behind it"
- 6. Wants: A plaque with Skipper Albury's story and the history of the area
- 7. Wants: Request that the City get the county's nets up and working so people can also go over there and play instead of crowding the Bayview courts
- 8. Wants: Requested a playground that is more special needs friendly. E.X. Sensory and interactive pieces
- 9. Wants: potentially turning the dead zone behind the double tennis courts into the dedicated art space
- 10. Wants: Friday night movie nights at the park, so a pull-down projector screen on the already existing pavilion
