Section 1: That a Task Order to Tetra Tech, Inc. is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$52,342.00 for a structural assessment of the liveaboard seawall at City Marina at Garrison Bight.

Section 2: That a necessary budget transfer from the Liveaboard Capital Improvement Fee fund Account 413-0000-223-1400 to Marina Operations Professional Services Account 413-7551-575-3100 is hereby authorized. Upon approval, a purchase order will be issued to Tetra Tech, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$52,342.00. Any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

execute any necessary documents, upon the advice and consent
of the City Attorney, that are consistent with this Task Order
