A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING KEY MUSIC FESTIVALS, LLC TO CONDUCT A KICKOFF EVENT WITH A FREE CONCERT DURING THE KEY WESTERN FEST ON THE 200 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET AND GREENE STREET BETWEEN TELEGRAPH LANE & ANN STREETS ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2023, FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 10:00 PM; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Key Music Festivals, Inc. wishes to conduct a street closure for a free concert on the 200 block of Duval Street between Duval & Greene Street between Telegraph Lane & Ann Streets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City

SECTION 3. Key Music Festivals, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct a concert on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. Key Music Festivals, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash container will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
