WHEREAS, in Resolution 21-028 the City of Key West accepted a Grant Award from the Tourist Development Council to assist with a tourism impact study and with the purchase and installation of sunshades at Mallory Square (Agreement ID #2485), and in Resolution 22-042 the City Commission approved Amendment (1st Amendment) to Agreement, extending the Agreement for this project; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approving the attached Amendment to Agreement ID #2485, which grants a no-cost time extension for the project; and
