Dear Mayor Johnston:

The Department of Economic Opportunity ("Department") has completed its review of the proposed comprehensive plan amendment for the City of Key West (Amendment No. 22-06ACSC), which was received on November 10, 2022 and determined complete on November 14, 2022. We have reviewed the proposed amendment in accordance with the state coordinated review process set forth in Sections 163.3184(2) and (4), Florida Statutes (F.S.), for compliance with Chapter 163, Part II, F.S. The Department does not identify any objections or comments to the proposed amendment and this letter serves as the Objections, Recommendations and Comments Report. Review comments received by the Department from the appropriate reviewing agencies, if any, are enclosed.

The City should act by choosing to adopt, adopt with changes, or not adopt the proposed amendment. For your assistance, we have enclosed the procedures for final adoption and transmittal of the comprehensive plan amendment. **The second public hearing**, which shall be a hearing on whether to adopt one or more comprehensive plan amendments, **must be held within 180 days** of your receipt of the Department's attached report, or the amendment will be deemed withdrawn unless extended by agreement with notice to the Department and any affected party that provided comment on the amendment pursuant to Section 163.3184(4)(e)1., F.S.

Dear Ms. Halloran:

Pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes (F.S.), in its role as a reviewing agency as identified in Section 163.3184(1)(c), F.S., the Florida Department of Transportation, District Six, reviewed the proposed amendment to Key West's Comprehensive Plan. The site-specific amendment would modify the City's Future Land Use Map category from Historic Residential to Historic Commercial for a 0.38-acre parcel located at Whitehead Street and Petronia Street, which is near the west end of the island.

The District reviewed the amendment package per Chapter 163 Florida Statutes and found the proposed amendment would not adversely impact transportation resources and facilities of state importance.

In addition, the District's number one priority is safety for all road users with an ultimate goal of zero fatalities and serious injuries. It is recommended that Key West continue to identify and address the safety needs of all modes of travel, including public transportation. The District encourages the City to include pedestrian and bicycle facilities to promote a safe walkable and connected community consistent with ss. 163.3177, Florida Statutes.

The Office of Intergovernmental Programs of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the above-referenced amendment package under the provisions of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. Dear Ms. Powell:

The South Florida Water Management District (District) has completed its review of the two separate proposed Comprehensive Plan amendments submitted by the City of Key West (City), Amendments #22-6ACSC and #22-7ACSC. Amendment #22-6ACSC includes a Future Land Use Map Amendment. No comments are being raised on the Amendment.

Amendment #22-7ACSC includes the City's Water Supply Facilities Work Plan Update (Work Plan). The District provides the following comments on the Work Plan under Section 163.3184(3)(4)(g), Florida Statutes, (F.S.). The important state resource impacted by this amendment is regional water supply. These comments should be addressed before final adoption of this amendment. If these comments are not addressed prior to adoption, the District may recommend the state land planning agency, the Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), to challenge the amendment.

Appendix C Water Supply Facilities Work Plan: City of Key West Comprehensive Plan

• The proposed Amendment Adoption Ordinance states that the City's Comprehensive Plan was being amended to replace Appendix C: City of Key West Water Supply Facilities Work Plan as well as amending identified objectives and policies in the following Comprehensive Plan

Chapters and Elements: Chapter 1: Future Land Use, Chapter 4: Public Facilities, Chapter 5: Coastal Management, Chapter 6: Conservation, Chapter 8: Intergovernmental Coordination; and Chapter 9: Capital Improvements. Appendix C is intended to include the Work Plan's relevant and appropriate data and analysis and the objectives and policies to implement the Work Plan. The objectives and policies to be amended are included in the Proposed Amendment Adoption Ordinance with the proposed changes presented in a strike through and underline format.

However, the Proposed Amendment and Proposed Adoption Ordinance, as submitted, only includes the objectives and policies that are to be amended and do not include a proposed revised Appendix C and the relevant and appropriate data and analysis for which the Work Plan is to be based on, as required in Sections 163.3177(1)(f) and 163.3177(3)(c), F.S.

Revise the Amendment to include an Appendix C that includes the relevant and appropriate data and analysis for which the Work Plan will be based on, and not just the objectives and policies. The Work Plan should clearly identify how the Work Plan will be adopted and incorporated into the City's Comprehensive Plank, as required by 163.3177(1)(b), F.S.

The District's Work Plan Technical Assistance Guide (TA Guide) includes planning tools to assist in updating the existing City Work Plan and is available on the District's website for your use. The TA Guide is located at this website link: https://www.sfwmd.gov/doing-business-with-us/work-plans.

Chapter 4: Public Facilities Element

- Revise the first paragraph of Objective 4-1.2 to state that the City will comply and implement the Water Supply Facilities Work Plan 2020-2030, as included in Appendix C of the City's Comprehensive Plan.
- Revise the second paragraph of Objective 4-1.2 to specify that the City is adopting by reference into the City's Work Plan and Comprehensive Plan the Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority's (FKAA) Capital Improvement Program and the most recent 20-Year Water System Master Plan. Include in the reference for each FKAA document the title and author and indicate clearly what provisions and edition (or date) of the documents are being adopted, consistent with the requirements of Section 163.3177(1)(b), F.S.

Chapter 8: Intergovernmental Coordination Element

- Revise Policy 8-1.3.5 to specify how the City coordinates with the FKAA, the District, and other
 relevant local governments and agencies, for water services that are planned for, adequately
 available, and provided to the water customers of the City. The Policy should address the
 following, as applicable:
 - o On-going coordination activities.
 - Needs for additional or updated coordination activities.
 - Coordination with the LEC Plan Update.
 - o Coordination with City of Florida City activities that affect the City's wellfield area.

If intergovernmental coordination activities are adequate and no new activities will be needed.

the Work Plan should include a narrative of how this was determined and how all issues listed above have been addressed.

Chapter 9: Capital Improvements Element

Revise Policy 9-4.1.3 to specify that the City is adopting by reference into the City's Five -Year Schedule of Capital Improvements and Comprehensive Plan the FKAA Capital Improvement Program. Include in the reference for the FKAA Capital Improvement Program the title and author and indicate clearly what provisions and edition (or date) of the documents are being adopted, consistent with the requirements of Section 163.3177(1)(b), F.S. Summary information should be included in the Comprehensive Plan, even if detailed information is incorporated by reference.
