
Key West Rides On-Demand Transit


- Post-and-hitch bollard-style bicycle racks are on-hand and being installed by Community Services.

- Southard St construction completed, Status of bicycle facility in flux pending amendment to parking contract with Monroe County
- Flagler Pedestrian Upgrades largely completed, but awaiting part order
- United St Construction underway, expected completion Nov 2023
- Final Mile Construction underway with concrete pours primarily within Key West / Stock Island, expected completion Nov 2023
- Whitehead St West side sidewalk under construction, target completion: Summer 2023
- S Roosevelt Blvd Construction underway with shared use path detours. Target completion date Spring 2025
- Keys COAST target completion Summer 2023
- Staples Ave Pedestrian Bridge is finishing the design stage, targeting release June 2023

 - FDOT to install and maintain non-motorized counter at replacement bridge
- Caroline St bicycle infrastructure finalizing design and expected in-house routing
- South St bicycle infrastructure is in vendor design, preliminary plans were expected March 2023

- North Roosevelt Blvd at Palm Ave (434684-4-52-01) is expected to begin construction phase in 2023
- North Roosevelt Blvd (FM# 446011-1): Finishing scoping phase. Draft Safety Audit is under review, identifying non-motorist crashes. The summary suggests that by constructing the recommended alternative, a reduction of three crashes per year can be achieved.
- Salt Ponds Trails Related ILA with Monroe County passed March 2023 (T.6.#11868). A scope of work
 to determine feasibility is expected to require coordination with USACE, FDEP, USFWS, National
 Marine Fisheries Service, and the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary.
