A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AND THE CONCH REPUBLIC INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATION, AIDS HELP, INC., THE KEY WEST CULTURAL PRESERVATION SOCIETY, BOURBON STREET PUB, PETRONIA ST. NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION, KEY WEST CULTURAL PRESERVATION & XENA FUND FOR THE 2012 CONCH REPUBLIC INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATION FROM APRIL 20 THROUGH APRIL 29, 2012; GRANTNG AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCES PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCE DURING THE CELEBRATION; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. That the attached agreement among the City of Key West and the Conch Republic Independence Celebration, Aids Help, Inc., Key West Cultural Preservation Society, Bourbon Street Pub, Petronia Street Neighborhood Association and Xena Fund is hereby approved, conditioned upon the applicant providing notice to all residents within 300 feet of the Bourbon Street Pub for the event to take place at the 700 & 800 blocks of Duval Street. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Key West; and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Key West; and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to his signature and affix the Seal of the City thereto.

Section 2. That all neighboring property owners and/or tenants shall be notified of the events approved in the attached agreement.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission

Section 4. The Conch Republic Independence will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.
