

4 YEAR PERIOD ANALYSIS


During the period, the total number of calls to the police department varied by about 7% from the median first up then down then up. The number of reports varied by about 3% from the median with no particular relationship to the number of calls. The number of RRIs varied by about 31% from the median with a relatively steady rise in the takedown category. I could not determine a correlation between calls, reports and RRIs but suspect that a recent initiative to better define and report takedowns lead to the increase in takedown reporting and, in return, the number of RRIs.

Considering this, and that the incidents were found to be necessary and in compliance, I am not going to recommend a change in the training program or corrective action without further information.







During the accreditation period, the total number of calls to the police department varied by about 6% from the median first up then down. The number of reports varied by less than 1% from the median with no particular relationship to the number of calls. The number of RRIs varied by about 26% from the median on a relatively steady rise almost identical in all categories. I could not determine a correlation between calls, reports and RRI's.

Considering this, and that the incidents were found to be necessary and in compliance, I am not going to recommend a change in the training program or corrective action without further information.
