3rd paragraph: Insert as a 2nd sentence "The 1-1-1 model that exist has a significant contributing factor to boost in recycling rates has resulted in a reduction in garbage volume."

6th paragraph: Insert as a 2nd sentence "Projected cost of 14 million dollars over entire term of the contract which included the additional cost for creating a Transfer Station".
