ORDINANCE THE CITY OF KEY WEST OF GRANTING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 9 ADDING RELATED EXHIBIT A-1TO THE A FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY DUCK TOURS SEAFARI, D/B/A YELLOW DUCK TOURS TO AMEND THE TYPE OF SIGHTSEEING VEHICLE(S) FRANCHISE PERMITTED BY THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 11-02 the City Commission approved a franchise agreement between the City and Duck Tours Seafari, d/b/a Yellow Duck Tours; and

WHEREAS, the owner of Duck Tours Seafari has requested an amendment to the franchise agreement, to allow an additional type of sightseeing vehicle to be used for sightseeing/shuttle operations.

WHEREAS, Key West City Charter section 7.01(4) requires that the grant of a franchise must be done by ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST FLORIDA:

Section 1: That "Section 9." of the Franchise Agreement contained in Ordinance No. 11-02 is hereby amended as follows*:

Section 9. CONSIDERATION FOR GRANT AND AUTHORIZED NUMBER OF VEHICLES

* * * * *

amphibious sightseeing vehicles under the provisions of this franchise. In the event that the Grantee can document through the use of a professional traffic impact or related study acceptable to the City that no adverse effects would be permitted upon the allowance of additional vehicles, the City Commission shall agenda an item for consideration of an amendment to this ordinance to permit additional vehicles.

True and accurate color photographs of the vehicles authorized to be used in the operation are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and "A-1".

Section 2: That Franchisee shall execute a First Amendment to Franchise Agreement that recognizes this addition.

Section 3: Except as specifically provided herein, this amendment to franchise ordinance No. 11-02 is not intended to waive any requirement of the franchise ordinance, the Key West City Code of Ordinances or City Charter.

Section 4: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of the Franchise Agreement.

Section 5: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.
