Description of event

At 5:00 Saturday August 2ndrd Citizens of the Conch Republic will begin mustering at Mallory Square. All Citizens are invited. Dignitaries that will be invited to attend are Conch Republic Prime Minister Craig Cates, Representative Joe Garcia, Representative Holly Raschein, Monroe County Commissioners, and City of Key West Commissioners.

Representatives of the United States Coast Guard, and the US Navy are also expected to be in attendance along with members of the military forces of the Conch Republic including the Navy, Air Force, Army, Special Ops, and The CIA (Cuties in Action).

At 5:30 pm Conch Republic Admiral Finbar will begin a short introduction and members of the military will do a gun salute to Sir Peter. Sir Peter will be relieved of his earthly duties and sent on his way to King Mel's Round Table.

The Honor Guard made up of US Military and Conch Republic Military will fold both the US Flag and Conch Republic Flag and present them to Sir Peter's daughter Mikaela.

At 5:45pm the Conch Republic Air Force will do a fly by in the Missing Man Formation. The Coast Guard is being asked be

stationed off shore and to fire off the water canons in the harbor simultaneously. The latest time for departure from Mallory Square is 6:00 pm.

Immediately after the Fly by, the parade will depart Mallory Square and will proceed to Front Street and subsequently make a right turn down Duval Street. The Parade will continue down Duval to the Atlantic. After the Parade there will be a Celebration of Sir Peter's life at Southernmost Beach Cafe. Approximate start time of the Celebration of a Life Well Led will end shortly after Sunset.

Parade participants will be riding in cars, riding bicycles, walking and there may be a few floats. This is the same type of Parade as The World's Longest Parade which is part of the Conch Republic Independence Celebration.

The City is being asked to also provide a riderless horse to be in the parade as well as approving the firing of guns for the salute to Sir Peter at Mallory Square. We are also respectfully requesting that parking at Mallory to be free and limited to Parade participants from 4:45 pm to 6:00 pm on August 3^{rd.} Parade would be monitored by Key West City Police and they would also provide police escorts at the head of the parade and divert vehicular traffic during the parade.

During The Celebration of Life, presentations would be made, memories of Sir Peter shared, and a toast or two made in his honor.

Sir Peter Anderson was loved and revered by many in our community. He gave so much to so many and his final wish was just one more parade. It is fitting that we honor him in this fashion.
