An application was received for the removal **of (1) Sapodilla tree**. A site inspection was done on July 24, 2014 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Sapodilla (Manilkara zapota)



Diameter: 33"

Location: 60% (possible root impacts to foundations)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 60% (fair-two trunks, codominant-one is more of a main with the second trunk smaller, can see obvious fissure, some decay in canopy)


Total Average Value = 73%

Value x Diameter = 24 replacement caliper inches





You submitted two applications for tree removal. The first application, for the removal of a sapodilla tree, a protected tree species, permit application number 7011, will be heard at the August 12, 2014 Tree Commission meeting.

The second application was for the removal of a pink tabebuia tree located along the driveway. Pink Tabebuia trees are not protected unless they are over 24" diameter. I measured the diameter of the tree and it is 16.9" diameter, therefore, no permit is required for the removal of the pink tabebuia tree along the driveway.
