WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 12-094, the City Commission approved a "First Amendment to Contract"; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-090, the City Commission approved a "Second Amendment to Contract," which extended the contract on a month-to-month basis upon negotiated terms for up to 12 months; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 14-168, the City Commission authorized further negotiations for a contract extension to adequately address any unforeseen circumstances with the integration of EMS services into the Key West Fire Department (KWFD); and

WHEREAS, KWFD staff recommends approval of an additional three-month extension, on a month-to-month basis, upon negotiated terms set forth in the attached Third Amendment to Contract, through June, 2015.
