AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AD VALOREM TAX GENERAL MUNICIPAL MILLAGE RATE FOR FY 2014-2015; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1*: That the final adopted ad valorem tax general municipal millage rate for FY 2014-2015 is hereby set at 2.8818 2.8174 mills (\$2.8818 \$2.8174 per thousand dollars of assessed property value). The 2014-2015 final adopted millage rate is 9.164 6.72 percent more than the 2014-2015 rolled back rate of 2.6399 mills (\$2.6399 per thousand dollars of assessed property value).

Section 2: That this Ordinance is adopted in accordance with Chapter 200.065, Florida Statutes.

Section 3: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.
