A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF ONE SURPLUS 2002 BOSTON WHALER FIRE BOAT TOGETHER WITH ONE 2002 CONTINENTAL BOAT TRAILER BY HITCH-KING FOR A MINIMUM BID OF AT LEAST \$10,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, a City-owned Boston Whaler fire boat, originally acquired for more than \$20,000.00, is surplus and obsolete, and City staff recommends disposal of the vessel together with it's Hitch King trailer, to the highest bidder, with a minimum bid of \$10,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the disposal of one surplus and obsolete City-owned 2002 Boston Whaler, with 2002 Continental Boat Trailer by Hitch King, as described in the attached Letter of Release, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the vessel and the trailer shall be sold to the highest bidder via a sealed bid process, with a minimum bid of no less than \$10,000.00.

Section 3: That the City Manager, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to complete the transaction.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
