I. Key West Bight Operations:

- Trimming coconut palms and cleaning up planting beds throughout property
- Requesting quotes for window placement in Harborwalk Tenants Showers and Laundry
- Air conditioning units approved for Harborwalk Tenants Showers and Laundry awaiting installation of windows to complete
- Air conditioning units approved and scheduled for installation at Margaret Street restrooms
- Minor repair and painting scheduled for exterior back wall of Sebago Office on Lazy Way
- Investigating new property wide surveillance system and will prepare request for quotes
- Construction has begun for the stormwater/outfall installation on William Street. Piping and structures to be in place in approximately five weeks. Roundabout sidewalk work scheduled to begin November 1st. Pedestrian and bicycle traffic to waterfront being maintained.

Key West Bight Marina:

- Fantasy fest is coming up in the last week of October and at this time we have one slip open.
- Florida powerboat races are coming in the first week of November and at this time we have 2 slips open.
- We are painting the pilings on the fuel dock.
- Checked all dock cleats on D dock and E dock.
- 9,361 passengers passed through the ferry terminal this September compared to 9,412 last September.
