ORDINANCE NO. 91-33

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING BOAT RAMP FEES FOR THE MUNICIPAL MARINA AT GARRISON BIGHT; INSTITUTING A DAILY VEHICLE PARKING FEE FOR SAID MARINA; PROVIDING THAT USERS OF COMMERCIAL VESSELS MAY NOT OBTAIN ANNUAL RAMP PERMITS AND MUST PAY DAILY RAMP AND VEHICLE PARKING FEES; PROVIDING THAT SAID CHANGES SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 1991; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is advisable to increase boat ramp fees for the municipal marina at Garrison Bight and make certain other changes to the user fee structure in order to increase City revenues and offset cost increases to the City of provision of services;

WHEREAS, the PATA Board has recommended that the City Commission adopt such changes, and the City Commission has the authority to set rates and determine conditions for marina usage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida as follows:

Section 1. Beginning on October 1, 1991, the following boat ramp rates shall apply for the municipal marina at Garrison Bight:

Ramp fee per launch

\$ 5.00

Annual ramp permit (recreational vessels/users only) \$ 30.00

Section 2. Owners and users of any car, truck, trailer, or other vehicle parking in the parking area adjacent to the boat ramp shall pay a parking fee of \$ 6.00 per day or portion thereof.

Section 3. Owners and users of commercial vessels: 1. must pay the ramp fee set forth in Section 1. above, and 2. may not obtain the annual boat ramp permit referred to in Section 2. above, but rather must pay the daily boat ramp fee for each separate use.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
