A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDING THE BID OF THE STRAITS LIGHTING COMPANY, LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF LED LIGHTING FIXTURES, HARDWARE AND POLES, AND REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF REPLACED LIGHT FIXTURES AT THE PARK N RIDE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS SPECIFIED IN ITB #14-025 IN NOT TO EXCEED \$41,873.50; AN AMOUNT AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS CONTAINED IN THE PACKAGE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2014 one bid was opened in response to ITB #14-025, for Park N Ride LED Light Fixtures Phase II, and city staff determined that the bid was responsive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Straits Lighting Company, LLC. for the purchase, delivery and installation of LED lighting fixtures, hardware and poles, and removal and disposal of replaced light fixtures at the Park N Ride, in accordance with the terms specified in ITB #14-025, is hereby awarded in an amount not to exceed \$41,873.50.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the contract documents contained within the bid package on behalf of the City of Key West upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.
