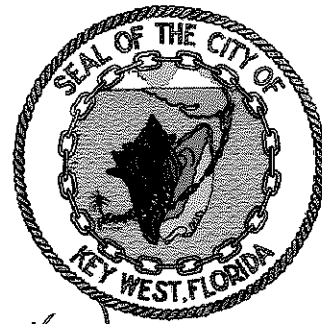

ACTION STATEMENT:

This is a request for approval to award ITB #11-011 - Light Fixtures for Park N Ride - in the amount of \$ 54,796.00 to LED Lighting Solutions, LLC, for the purchase of replacement light fixtures, to be installed and used at Park N Ride.

PROJECT HISTORY:

Resolution No. 08-067 approved March 4, 2008, directed city staff to reduce municipal operational greenhouse gases (includes carbon emissions) by 15% by the year 2015. Replacing exterior facility lighting with LED technology will significantly contribute to this reduction.

Replacing existing light fixtures which have begun to fail over the past two (2) to three (3) year period will provide an annual cost savings over our current lighting system, reduce the annual KWH usage and reduce the annual carbon footprint or greenhouse gases, all at the same time. These reductions will not only provide a cost savings to the City, but allow the City of Key West to meet goals set and the Park N Ride Lot to become a more environmentally responsible facility.

There were a total of six (6) bids received and opened on May 25, 2011, at 3:00 pm, in the City Clerk's Office. City staff members from KWDoT, Engineering, and Community Services met in an effort to compile and review the bid data received by the Clerk's Office as part of the bid response process.

Attached for your review and use is a bid summary that organizes all information collected from the bid documents in a consistent manner and in accordance with the information that was requested in the bid specification package.

Based on the total savings over the life of the fixtures; and substantial reductions in carbon footprint and kilowatt hour usage, the Key West Department of Transportation staff recommend LED Lighting Solutions, LLC be awarded the bid.

While Creative Lighting has the lowest, initial cost by price, the most responsive bidder who has the lowest cost based upon all elements in the ITB is LED Lighting Solutions, LLC. This vendor reduces the greenhouse gases to the greatest extent (24%) and reduces the electricity used each month the most. After the sixth year, LED Lighting Solutions will save the City an additional \$2,700 in annual energy costs over what Creative Lighting would cost.

OPTION #1:

Option #1 would see the City approve the resolution requested and award the bid to LED Lighting Solutions, LLC, in the amount of \$ 54,796.00 to proceed with replacing the light fixtures at Park N Ride.

Advantages

The biggest advantage to this option is the reduction of greenhouse gases and electricity used monthly at that facility. Thereby assisting the City of Key West in meeting the goal set for 15% reduction of greenhouse gases by 2015, to all municipal operational facilities.

Disadvantages

There are no disadvantages to awarding this bid to LED Lighting Solutions, LLC.

Financial Impact

This project was approved and budgeted at \$98,580, so many of the bids received are well within the budgeted amount. It should be noted that if the award is approved as recommended by KWDoT staff, it will save the City \$43,784. This does not include a minimal cost that may be paid to the City's FMT division for installation - should that be required.

OPTION #2:

Option #2 would see the City not approve this bid award; and reject all bids received and forgo any improvement to the lighting system at the Park N Ride.

Advantages

The advantage to this option would be that the City would not spend any of the \$98,580 budgeted at this time.

Disadvantages

The disadvantage to this option is that the current light fixtures have begun to fail, will continue to deteriorate and break as they continue to age out which will inevitably cause potentially hazardous and liable situations for the City. At some point there will be no other alternative but to replace the light fixtures at the Park N Ride.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact to this option is a minimum of \$8,650.82 per year in maintenance expenses to the City for repair of the existing light fixtures, plus the added cost of higher electricity each month.

RECOMMENDATION

KWDoT staff recommends the bid be awarded to LED Lighting Solutions, LLC.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO REDUCE THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS BY 15% BY 2015; AND FURTHER SETTING A GOAL OF REDUCING GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS THROUGHOUT THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST BY 15% BY 2015; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 07-273, the City Commission committed to five milestones to reduce greenhouse gas and air pollution emissions, set forth in the International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI)'s Cities for Climate Protection Campaign, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and visitors of Key West, and the planet; and

WHEREAS, the first milestone completed was the City of Key West Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory Report, which provides a baseline inventory of City energy use and emissions in FY 2005; and

WHEREAS, the second milestone is to set a target for emissions reductions and the third step is to create a Local Climate Action Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City staff is hereby directed to reduce municipal operations' greenhouse gas emissions by 15%, by the year

2015, based upon the 2005 baseline data contained in the City of Key West Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory Report.

Section 2: That City staff is hereby directed to work to develop a Climate Action Plan for reducing greenhouse gas emissions within the jurisdiction of the City of Key West by 15% by the year 2015.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.



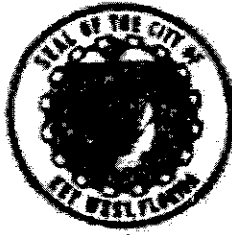

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids addressed to the City of Key West (CITY), for the Invitation to Bid (ITB) # 11-011: PARK-N-RIDE LIGHT FIXTURES will be received at the office of the City Clerk, City of Key West, Florida, until 3:00 p.m., local time, on May 25, 2011 and then will be publicly opened and read. Any Bids received after the time and date specified will not be considered.

The project contemplated consists of providing all materials to replace the existing 133 light fixtures at the City of Key West Park-N-Ride.

Specifications may be obtained from DemandStar by Onvia or from the City of Key West website (www.keywestcity.com). Please contact DemandStar at www.demandstar.com or call 1-800-711-1712.

One (1) original, one (1) copy, and 2 CD copies or flash drives in PDF format of the Bid are to be submitted in two sealed envelopes, one within the other, clearly marked on the outside "ITB # 11-011: PARK-N-RIDE LIGHT FIXTURES", and addressed to the City Clerk.

The CITY may reject Bids: (1) for budgetary reasons, (2) if the Bidder misstates or conceals a material fact in its Bid, (3) if the Bidder does not strictly conform to the law or is non-responsive to Bid requirements, (4) if the Bid is conditional, (5) if a change of circumstances occurs making the purpose of the Bid unnecessary or (6) if such rejection is in the best interest of the CITY. The CITY may also waive any minor informalities or irregularities in any Bid.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. TYPE OF BID

LUMP SUM

The Bid for the items is to be submitted on a LUMP SUM basis. LUMP SUM prices shall be broken down on a unit price basis for each item in the Bid and a Schedule of Values shall be included with the bid. The total amount to be paid the Bidder shall be the amount of the Lump Sum Bid, to include freight FOB/Key West, and as adjusted for additions or deletions in number of units. The owner reserves the right to enter into a contract for all or portions of the items and to adjust the final number of items accordingly.

2. PREPARATION OF BIDS

GENERAL

All blank spaces in the Bid form must be filled in, as required, in BLACK INK or TYPED. All price information will be shown in both words and figures where required. No changes shall be made in the phraseology of the forms. Written amounts shall govern in case of discrepancy between amounts stated in writing and the amounts stated in figures.

Any Bid shall be deemed informal, which contains omissions, erasures, alterations, or additions of any kind, or prices uncalled for, or in which any of the prices are obviously unbalanced, or which in any manner shall fail to conform to the conditions of the published ITB.

Bidders shall not submit unbalanced bids as requested in the breakdown of bids.

Only one (1) Bid from any individual, firm, partnership, or corporation under the same or different names, will be considered. Should it appear to the Owner that any Bidder is interested in more than one (1) Bid for work contemplated, all Bids in which such Bidder is interested will be rejected.

3. SIGNATURE

The Bidder shall sign his/her Bid in the blank space provided therefore. If Bidder is a corporation, the legal name of the corporation shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the officer or officers authorized to sign Contracts on behalf of the corporation. If the Bidder is a partnership, the true name of the firm shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the partner or partners authorized to sign Contracts on behalf of the partnership. If signature is by an agent, other than an officer of a corporation or a member of a partnership, a notarized power of attorney must be on file

with the Owner prior to opening of Bids or submitted with the Bid, otherwise the Bid will be regarded as not properly authorized.

4. ATTACHMENTS

Bidder shall complete and submit the following forms with his Bid or as otherwise identified in the bid document:

5. STATE AND LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX

The Owner is exempt from state sales tax on materials. Bidder, as required by the laws and statutes of the state and its political subdivisions, shall pay all state and local sales and use taxes unless stated differently in these documents. Prices quoted in the Bid shall include all nonexempt sales and use taxes, unless provision is made in the Bid form to separately itemize the tax.

6. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

All Bids must be submitted not later than the time prescribed, at the place, and in the manner set forth in the ITB. Bids must be made on the Bid forms provided herewith.

Each Bid must be submitted in two sealed envelopes; one within the other, so marked as to indicate the Bidder's name and its contents without being opened, and addressed in conformance with the instructions in the ITB. One original and one copy are required.

7. MODIFICATIONS OR WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

Prior to the time and date designated for receipt of Bids, any Bid submitted may be modified or withdrawn by notice to the party receiving Bids at the place designated for the receipt of Bids. Such notice shall be in writing over the signature of the Bidder or by telephone, fax, or email. If by telephone, fax, or email, written confirmation over the signature of the Bidder shall be mailed and postmarked on or before the date and time set for receipt of Bids, and it shall be so worded as not to reveal the amount of the original Bid.

8. AWARD OF CONTRACT

Within sixty (60) calendar days after the opening of the Bids, the Owner will accept one of the Bids. The acceptance of the Bid will be by issuance of a purchase order. In the event of failure of the lowest, responsive, qualified Bidder supply the items with the

specified time, the Owner may award the Contract to the next lowest, responsive, qualified Bidder.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and/or all Bids because of irregularities or due to budgetary considerations, to waive irregularities or informalities in any or all Bids, and to accept any Bid that it deems to be in the best interest of the Owner.

9. **BASIS OF AWARD**

The Owner on the basis of that Bid will make the award from the lowest, responsive, qualified Bidder that in the Owner's sole and absolute judgment will serve the best interests of the Owner.

If at the time this Contract is to be awarded, the total of the lowest acceptable Bid exceeds the funds then estimated by the Owner as available, the Owner may reject all Bids or take such other action as best serves the Owner's interest.

10. **TIME OF COMPLETION**

The Bidder further agrees to furnish the items within six (6) weeks (weekends and holidays included) of issuance of the purchase order.

11. **PAYMENT TERMS**

The Bidder will invoice the City once for the items requested. Terms of payment will be a maximum of 45 days from receipt of invoice.
