Wesley House Family Services is a Full Case Management services provider of child welfare services in Monroe County. Many of the families served are homeless at the initiation of services. Wesley House works with the families to rehabilitate many of the factors that led to the homelessness and placed children at risk of abuse and/or neglect. A portion of the children served are removed from their parents and placed with relatives or foster parents. Once the parent demonstrates the ability to safely parenting the children, Wesley House seeks court approval for reunification.

A barrier to timely reunification in Monroe County is affordable housing for families. Many parents cannot afford the required first, last and security deposits that most rentals require. In the past, Wesley House has entered a sublease agreement for Building #1623, Unit #3 at the Poinciana Site with the Housing Authority of the City of Key West and has utilized this unit for office space of its Healthy Families Program. It has been determined that a more appropriate and needed use of this property is to provide transitional housing for one family at a time. Wesley House staff will work with the family to access additional resources leading to permanent housing. The use of this property for transitional housing and services Wesley House will provide or facilitate meet the written operational guidelines of the Homeless Assistance Submission portion of the Key West Base Reuse Plan.
